#### First Reading: Isaiah 56:1, 6-7

God invites all people to come and share in the promises made to Israel. Not only the Jewish people, but everyone is invited to keep the covenant and enter God's house, which is open not to a single tribe, but to all people. Isaiah's vision should be our vision for our churches: God's house is "a house of prayer for all peoples."

#### Second Reading: Romans 11:13-15, 29-32

Paul continues his reflection on the Jewish people - his people. He knows that Christ is the source of salvation; and he knows that God's promises are "irrevocable." Not all accept Christ, or turn towards him; but God desires to "have mercy upon all." God's plan unfolds according to his will and not ours.

#### Gospel: Matthew 15:21-28

The theme of insiders and outsiders appears in all today's readings. In the Gospel, a Canaanite woman - an outsider, part of a nation who were long enemies of Jews - approaches Jesus to beg healing for her daughter. The disciples try to send her away, but she stubbornly refuses to go. Even when Jesus tells her that he has come for Israel only, she keeps asking for what she needs, and Jesus grants it. God's love and Christ's compassion reach beyond our enemies and over our borders.



#### A STEWARDSHIP PRAYER





\*We thank Sio Tuitupou for his regular delivery of freshly picked papaya fruits from his garden to the Rectory refectory. Much mahalo!



#### \*RELIGIOUS ED PROGRAM\* WELCOME TO THE FIRST DAY OF THE School **CATECHETICAL YEAR 2017-18.**

As directed by the Diocese, the OPENING DAY OF THE SUNDAY SCHOOL for the Year 2017-2018 is today, August 20. On



this first day, there are no formal classes yet, but all children together with their parents are joining the celebration of the 147<sup>th</sup> Parish Anniversary starting with the Holy Mass at 8:30am, followed by a solemn procession to the grotto and fellowship for all at the parish hall.

REGISTRATION still goes on and forms are available in the bulletin holders. For those who are receiving the sacraments of Confirmation and First Communion, the Baptism *Certificate* is required. The celebration of the *Sacraments* of Confirmation and First Communion is set on May 20, 2018 which is the solemn Feast of Pentecost. First Reconciliation and Confessions is scheduled beforehand.

The catechists led by Sr. Clemence Mira, SPC and the Youth Ministry under Ropati Liua joined hands to implement the diocesan program of transitioning to the original order of celebrating the initiation sacraments. Team teaching will be part of the new structure. The role of the parents in the Christian formation of their children is also integrated in the program.

The identified programs for the Youth Ministry called EDGE and LIFE TEEN were ordered in both online and hard copy forms. Both programs cost \$1,595.00 and we are most grateful to the generous benefactor who donated the amount. God truly loves a cheerful giver!

Let's continue to pray for our children and youths. We thank the loving services of our ever-caring catechists who mold their minds and hearts with the Christian values and prepare them well for the sacraments of First Reconciliation, Confirmation and First Communion. Questions? kdeneve@rcchawaii.org Sometimes Catholics approach Confirmation like a graduation, saying, "I made my Confirmation," as if it is something that they earned after com-pleting X number of service hours or attending Y percentage of Confirma-

We the baptized do not "confirm" our faith in the sacrament of Confirma-tion. Rather, it is God who confirms us in the free gift of our faith: "He has put his seal on us and given us his Spirit in our hearts as a guaran-tage" (Enhorizon 1:12, 4:20) *tee*" (Ephesians 1:13, 4:30).

Pope Francis addressed this point in his general audience of Jan. 29, 2014: "Confirmation, like every sacrament, is not the work of men but of God, who cares for our lives in such a manner as to mold us in the image of his Son, to make us capable of loving like him. God does it by infusing in us his Holy Spirit, whose action pervades the whole person and his/her entire life.

Soon, seven-year-olds who were baptized as infants will be confirmed prior to receiving First Communion. (When this will happen depends on your parish plan.) God will perfect in them the grace received at Bap-tism, perfect in them the common priesthood of all the faithful (Catechism of the Catholic Church, Nos. 1305 and 1316).


#### CLERGY STUDY DAY
