



Pastor's Corner

Next Sunday's Readings

Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

First Reading Zechariah 9:9-10 Responsorial Psalm

Psalm 145"1-2,8-11, 13-14

Second Reading

Gospel

Romans 8:9, 11-13

Matthew 11:25-40

First Reading: 2 Kings 4:8-11, 14-16

Prophets are more often running for their lives than receiving a warm welcome, hut this reading from 2 Kings gives us an example of the latter situation. A widow in Shunem welcomes Elisha warmly and even provides him with his own room so that he can feel at home whenever he wishes to visit. Her hospitality is rewarded: the prophet tells her that she will soon have the son she has long wished for.

Second Reading: Romans 6:3-4, 8-11

We continue our reading of St. Paul's letter to the Romans with a key passage about Baptism which is also read at the great Easter Vigil. Baptism is nothing less than death and life. Through Baptism, we die with Christ, and share in the power of his Resurrection from the dead. We are not the same anymore: and we need to live like the new, redeemed people that we are.

Gospel: Matthew 10:37-42

Jesus warns his Apostles what to expect before he sends them out to proclaim the Gospel This will be no easy task and it requires a commitment beyond anything else in their lives, a bond even stronger than that between parent and child. And yet, the rewards are beyond measure, too, not only for the Apostles, but for all who help them: "whoever receives a prophet because he is a prophet will receive a prophet's reward," Jesus says, alluding to today's First Reading. The woman who welcomed Elisha out of love of God was rewarded beyond her imagining. When we welcome others in the name of Christ, we welcome Christ himself.

RELIGIOUS ED PROGRAM

Eight OLM parish catechists headed by *Sr. Clemence Mira*, *SPC*, attended the *Annual Faith Formation Conference* at St. Theresa Co-Cathedral School for their required updating and certification last <u>June 16-17</u>. The catechists who attended were: *Trini Agamao*, *Fe Go*, *Marilyn Goloran*, *Cathy Patoc*, *Lucille Mohika*, *Rosemary Mohika and Vangie Bacani*. The parish paid \$410.00 for their registration fee and meals.

Classes will resume in August wherein we shall start with the new diocesan program of implementing the original order of celebrating the initiation sacraments. That is, First Communion and Confirmation will be celebrated in the same year for Grade 2 and higher. Parents are expected to be more involved in the program through a working Family Ministry. At the same time, the required comprehensive Youth Ministry program must be fully implemented. The catechists under Sr. Clemence Mira, SPC and the Youth Ministry under Ropati Liua will collaborate on the latter matter. A joint meeting of the concerned ministries will be held on July 16, Sunday, at 10:00am.

Let's continue to pray for our children and youths. We thank the loving services of our ever-caring catechists who mold their minds and hearts with the Christian values and prepare them well for the sacraments of *First Reconciliation*, *First*

Communion and Confirmation. We laud the parents, grandparents and guardians who encourage their children to attend the Sunday Mass and act as primary catechists by their own teachings and concrete examples of living the Christian faith.


