

190™ ANNIVERSARY OF CATHOLICISM IN HAWAII

July 9, 2017, Sunday: Today is the feast day of Our Lady, Queen of Peace, principal patroness of the Diocese of Honolulu. This day also marks the 190th anniversary of the arrival of the first Catholic missionaries in Hawaii, namely, the members of the Congregation of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary. Although the feast of Our Lady of Peace is

celebrated only in Cathedral Basilica this year because it is a Sunday, parishes are encouraged to mark this momentous anniversary in some way special at the Sunday Masses. This may be an opportune time to emphasize the missionary nature of the Church and to encourage parishioners to take the Gospel out to their families, their schools, their places of work, and to the public square.

Pastor's Corner

Next Sunday's Readings

Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

First Reading Isaiah 55:10-11

Responsorial Psalm

Psalm 65:10-14

Second Reading Romans 8:18-23 Gospel

Matthew 13:1-23

First Reading: Zechariah 9:9-10

Zechariah proclaims the coming of the Messiah in striking imagery. The king will not come on a warhorse, with a display of military might, but meekly, on a beast of burden. And yet, his power is beyond question as hen sweeps away chariots, horses, and weapons if war, and proclaims peace to the whole earth.

Second Reading: Romans 8:9, 11-13

Those who have been baptized into Christ are no longer "in the flesh" but rather "in the spirit." Through Baptism, we have become the dwelling-places of the Holy Spirit, and everything we do must take this great reality into account. We no longer live for this life only: we look to the life yet to come, which has already begun for us through Baptism.

Gospel: Matthew 11:25-40

Jesus praises God who reveals his wisdom not to the usual suspects - the wise, the learned, the important - but to those no one would expect: the little ones, the childlike. This passage ends with a wonderful invitation as Jesus calls all who carry heavy burdens to come to him and find rest. Jesus is "meek and humble of heart," the king of gentleness and power that Zechariah foretold.

RELIGIOUS ED PROGRAM

IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT: The catechists led by Sr. Clemence Mira, SPC and the Youth Ministry under Ropati Liua will hold a joint meeting on July 16, Sunday, at 10:00am. This is to prepare for the opening of the Sunday Catechism classes in the following month.

There is a minor revamped of the order of instruction to accommodate the new diocesan program of implementing the original order of celebrating the initiation sacraments. That is, First Communion and Confirmation will be celebrated in the same year for Grade 2 and higher starting in 2018. Parents are expected to be more involved in the program through a working Family Ministry and the required comprehensive Youth Ministry program must be fully implemented.

Let's continue to pray for our children and youths. We thank the loving services of our ever-caring catechists who mold their minds and hearts with the Christian values and prepare them well for the sacraments of *First Reconciliation*, *First Communion and Confirmation*. We laud the parents, grandparents and guardians who encourage their children to attend the Sunday Mass and act as primary catechists by their own teachings and concrete examples of living the Christian faith.

♦FACILITIES REPAIR ♦ MAINTENANCE ♦

Last week started the project of putting up a concrete fence on the makai side of the convent as well as concrete pavement on its frontage. Kalolo Tuihalafatai and his men dug the ground for the drainage canal and the foundation for the hollow tiles which they laid up next. Kalolo also oversaw the pouring of cement over the ground that will be used for additional parking spaces. Rudy Fiesta takes care of setting up the galvanized posts and railings. Our good neighbor and parishioner, Rosie Jacinto, donated the amount of \$2000.00 to help foot the expenses incurred.

This and other maintenance projects are being done with the parishioners' stewardship offering for Repair & Maintenance. We will soon begin the awaited renovation of the convent building starting with the flooring on both levels. Definitely, this needs more funding and we shall be ap-

pealing to the parishioners' kokua as we resume the monthly second collection for Re-Maintepair nance soon. We are most grateful for your support and generosity and may God repay you abundantly.
