Next Sunday's Readings

Twenty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

First Reading
Jeremiah 20:7-9

Responsorial Psalm Psalm 63:2-6. 8-9

Second Reading

Gospel

Romans 12:1-2

Matthew 16:21-27

First Reading: Isaiah 22:19-23

The First Reading describes the transferal of authority as Shebna is removed from his high post, master of the palace, and a new leader, Eliakim, put in his place and invested with all his power. God is the giver of authority.

Second Reading: Romans 11:33-36

This wonderful meditation on the mystery of God concludes the sequence of reading we have heard about the Jewish people, God's ways are beyond our understanding. We can only wonder and trust in the wisdom of God.

Gospel: Matthew 16:13-20

In the First Reading, God chose Eliakim as a leader for his people. Here, Jesus chooses Peter. Peter is chosen not because of his leadership potential - just two Sundays ago, our reading showed us a Peter who boldly stepped out onto the sea, but whose confidence quickly faded at the sight of the waves. Rather, Peter is chosen because he has learned to listen to the voice of God - for it is through God that Peter is able to recognize Jesus as the Christ. Peter is called the "rock," but the strength of the Church built upon him does not come from Peter, but rather from God.

These 4 attributes of a steward match up with 4 areas of focus for both individual Catholics and the parish: we receive God's gifts gratefully through prayer and worship focused on thanksgiving; we cultivate them responsibly through formation and education focused on learning more about stewardship and how to be better stewards; we share our gifts lovingly and in justice when we share them with others especially the less fortunate; and we can return them with increase to the Lord by giving adequately to the Lord's instrument here on earth, our Church.
