# Next Sunday's Reading 28th Sunday in Ordinary Time

First Reading Wisdom 7:7-11

Responsorial Psalm Psalm 90:12-17

Second Reading Hebrews 4:12-13 Gospel Mark 10:17-30

First Reading: Genesis 2:18-24

God created human beings for companionship with all of creation and with each other. Husband and wife become one flesh. God created them as partners in their relationship.

Second Reading: Hebrews 2:9-11

We are brothers and sisters of Christ, for God made him holy just as he, in turn, consecrates us. God perfected Jesus through his suffering and death so that having shared fully in our humanity, he might be the high priest who makes us holy.

**Gospel:** *Mark* 10:2-16

The Pharisees and the disciples both question Jesus about the legality of a husband divorcing his wife. What God has joined Jesus says human beings must not separate. The longer form of the Gospel reading includes Jesus' instruction to his disciples who were turning back the people bringing their children to him, to let the children come. There is no longer and shorter form of today's reading.

You are the promised one of Jesus, the ultimate protector of the church and its most vulnerable. You are the Lord, the giver of life who brings us


peace in the midst of storms and comfort in our pain and discouragement. You are the one who transforms weak and timid disciples into bold proclaimers of the Good News.

My doctor confirmed that my healing bordered the miraculous. I knew that it was through the power of prayer because I never took any medication for the paralysis.

Last year, I was also afflicted with breast cancer. I went through all the radiation treatments which took away all my hairs and made me bald. At the same time, prayers by my family, friends and church were offered on my behalf. Now, thank God, I'm still alive and feel great.

At the same breath, I committed all the more my time, resources and my whole self as a Catechist, Eucharistic Minister, Lector and member of the Outreach Ministry. Aside from the regular Sunday Masses that my family and I attend, I also join the Holy Hour, Novena and rosary prayers, Bible Study and Ilocano Ministry Mass. All these are what real stewardship for me is all about. It is giving back what God has bestowed upon us to help and support our church, community and country.

Fellow parishioners, I'm sure you have been cured or blessed by the Lord one way or another. My story could be your story with some variations. I hope I opened your heart and mind to be always grateful to the Lord in your prayers and in your participation at Mass and in other church activities. 
#### **MOSES & CRIS ANDRES**
