



Pastor's Corner

Next Sunday's Reading Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time

First Reading Sirach 27:4-7 Responsorial Psalm Psalm 92:2-3, 13-16

Second Reading 1 Corinthians 15:54-58 Gospel Luke 39-45

First Reading: 1 Samuel 26:2, 7-9, 12-13, 22-23

Stubborn, wicked, and immoral speech gain a person nothing. Rather, this type of speech contrasts with the wisdom of the Lord's Word. In a few pithy proverbs, the author of Sirach instructs us about how our words reveal both our faults and our goodness (the fruits we bear). Only after people speak can we praise them, for only then will we know if their speech has reflected the Lord's word.

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 15:45-49

Paul draws the connection between death and sin and acclaims that victory over death comes from God through our Lord Jesus Christ. Paul solidifies for the Corinthians and for us that death's sting is no more in Jesus Christ. Paul's words urge the community of believers to remain devoted to following the Lord for it leads to a share in Christ's Resurrection. This is a tall order for a community as divided as the Corinthians, but Paul knows they can succeed when they remain in the Lord.

Gospel: Luke 6:27-38

Jesus turns to short parables as he continues to teach the disciples on the plain. The disciples hear how their teacher will train them in his ways; how they should not judge another person when sin remains in them; and how trees are known by the fruit they bear—a direct connection to the First Reading from Sirach. The Gospel reading concludes as we hear Jesus speak what we could consider an obvious tautology: good comes from good and evil from evil. We speak what is in our heart—let that be goodness!


NOVENA TO PERPETUAL
