Next Sunday's Reading The Ascension of the Lord

First Reading Acts of the Apostles 1:1-11

Responsorial Psalm

Psalm 47:2-3.6-9

Second Reading Ephesians 1:17-23

Gospel

Matthew 28:16-20

FOCUS: The Holy Spirit is God's gift to those who follow him.

All three readings today mention the reception and action of the Holy Spirit. Confirmation in the Spirit completes Christian initiation in Samaria. Jesus, the model of Christian behavior, was brought to risen life in the Spirit. He bestows the Spirit of Truth on those who keep his commandments. As we approach the Eucharist, let us thank God for his gracious gift.

First Reading: Acts of the Apostles 8:5-8, 14-17

In the reading from the Acts of the Apostles, Philip goes to Samaria, proclaiming Jesus and working signs. Peter and John go there to lay hands on the newly baptized.

Second Reading: 1 Peter 3:15-18

In the second reading, Peter urges proper Christian conduct in imitation of Christ.

Gospel: John 14:15-21

In Jesus' farewell discourse, he promises to give the Spirit and to return soon. The disciples must keep his commandments.

NATIONAL EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL: 2022-2025

"Let's be Eucharistic Stewards"

On March 2020, the US government declared a medical emergency imposing safety and health protocols at the onset of the covid-19 pandemic. Many public institutions and businesses suffered a big hit and closed down. Citizens were advised to practice hygiene, wear mask or face covering, observe safe distancing and as much as possible to shelter in including working and N studying at home and avoiding large crowd gathering especially in walled structures. On their 2 part, the Catholic Churches duly followed all the guidance and restrictions which included halting the partaking of the Precious Blood of the Lord in Holy Communion.

Three days ago, on May 11, 2023 the United States government lifted the medical emergency and took out all the restrictions. They remind us, however, to stay on guard because the threat of

the covid variants still persists and they still make available needed vaccines. We pray that the Lord and our Blessed Mother will protect us from all harm.

In view of the government announcement, Bishop Silva has lifted the restriction on receiving the precious blood of Christ and declared its restoration in Holy Communion starting Holy Thursday. We at OLM abide by this memorandum and we shall resume our communion of both Body and Blood of our Lord on the weekend of May 27-28 which is the solemn feast of the coming down of the Holy Spirit and the birthday of the Church on Pentecost Sunday.

During this period of National Eucharistic Revival (2022-2025), may we have the fervent faith and intense desire to receive the Lord's Body and Blood in the Holy Eucharist.


STEWARDSHIP REFLECTIONS

Jesus has given each baptized Catholic a mission: "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you" (Mt 28:19-20). Our mission is to live this calling every day of our lives.

People are at the heart of the mission of the Church. Strengthening relationships, boldly growing engagement and connecting people to the mission are simple ways to



If we are all God's children, then we have a responsibility to help each other. We are meant to live in relationship, and to be the living presence of God in the world – to show his love to the people around us. This means treating people like family, not transactions. It's easy to do this with the people we enjoy being around. It's a lot harder to put into practice when we are talking about a coworker or acquaintance who drives us crazy. But like it or not, we are all called to this. For me this is a revolutionary idea: I am not better than anyone else. The world tries to separate us all the time by putting us into categories of race, gender or socioeconomic status. Those don't really matter. We are all children of God. It is important for all of us to try to see the people in front of us and love them like Jesus does. I invite you to join me in that, to strive each day to see people as your brothers and sisters and to treat them accordingly.

Aloha Pastors & Parish Staff,

Good news - the appeal is now tracking ahead of last year by 9% -- led by 23 parishes meeting their target goal. Special kudos to these faith communities recently over the top: St. Ann, Kaneohe & Sts. Peter & Paul, Honolulu.

PLEASE NOTE:

- -Parishes short of this year's required minimum 50% of target goal will be contacted in early June regarding fulfillment options*.
- -The final 'OIC 2022/2023 Report will include the assessment paid by each parish so as to acknowledge their total diocesan support.

And for 2023/2024

- -While the overall goal remains the same at \$1.125 million, parish target goals will fluctuate relative to changes in their assessment.
- -Target goals will be released once parish assessments are finalized, of which the required minimum increases to 75% (up from 50%).
- -Mail lists that are up-to-date can be included with the initial 'OIC mailing in September at no charge to the parish if interested, please contact me ASAP to discuss next steps.

OLM parish leader *Clementina D. Ceria-Ulep* has been appointed permanent dean of the *University of Hawaii Manoa Nancy Atmospera-Walch School of Nursing*. Prior to her promotion she was acting dean for 3 months in 2021 then made interim dean on November 1 of that year. Her appointment as full-pledged dean took effect on April 1.

Dr. Clementina is fully qualified to take over the position. She had a long career in health care since she earned her bachelor's and master's degree in nursing administration from UH Manoa and doctoral degree from the Medical College of Virginia Commonwealth University. She was faculty member of the School of Nursing and Dental Hygiene at UH Manoa since 1993 and taught in the undergraduate and graduate programs. Her clinical practice focuses on adult health and administration. In advancing this field, she was able to secure a grant from the National Institutes of Health to investigate the effects of increased physical activity and reduced sedentary time among

Filipino seniors who are members of the Filipino Catholic Clubs in the Diocese of Honolulu. She had other multiple initiatives in favor of the Nursing program that earned her honors and awards from the UH School of Nursing and Dental Hygiene, from the Philippine Nurses Association of Hawaii and fellow in the Pacific Century Fellows Program.

The Honolulu Star-Advertiser featured her in the local news section on March 27, 2023, page B2 by *Esme M. Infante*. We at OLM are certainly happy and proud of *Dr. Clementina*. She continues to follow up the well-being of elderly folks in a program called *"Ibasho"* where she involves the senior citizens in our parish. 
