ICSC 2023 Stewardship Conference To Focus on the Eucharist & Stewardship

This year the International Catholic Stewardship Council (ICSC) is focusing its efforts to emphasize the relationship between the Eucharist and Stewardship, and how the Eucharist informs stewardship through evangelization, engagement and missionary discipleship. Three specific areas will be dedicated to these themes: • How the Eucharist informs Stewardship and Evangelization • Enhancing Parish Communication and Engagement • Growing and Sustaining Parish Stewardship The plenary speakers and session presenters will offer reflections, ideas and resources to allow parishes to more robustly serve their mission. Even before the pandemic, parish leaders understood that pastoral structures that served their mission well in the past needed to be renewed and aligned with current pastoral demands. Issues arising in the aftermath of the pandemic have challenged parish leaders to think differently. The ICSC conference will provide resources for those who realize that the time is now to respond in faith to a new reality and to better equip parish communities for mission. This year’s conference is scheduled for October 1-4, 2023 at the Hyatt Regency Orlando Hotel in Orlando, Florida.

First Reading Deuteronomy 8:2-3, 14-16	Responsorial Psalm Psalm 147:12-15, 19-20
Second Reading 1 Corinthians 10:16-17	Gospel John 6:51-58

FOCUS: The Trinity is a mystery of faith and a communion of love. Today's feast celebrates one of the greatest mysteries of our faith: One God, made up of three persons sharing one divine substance – the Trinity. It is through God's self-revelation to us through Jesus Christ and his Paschal Mystery, that we come to know the Triune God from whom all life flows. *God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life.*

First Reading: Exodus 34:4-6, 8-9
 In the first reading, God proclaims himself to Moses as the gracious, merciful, and loving God of Israel.

Second Reading: 2 Corinthians 13:11-13
 In the second reading, Paul instructs the Corinthian community to live in encouragement, agreement, love, and peace, and ends with a blessing of the Trinity.

Gospel: John 3:16-18
 John proclaims in the Gospel that God gave the world *his only Son*, so that *everyone who believes in him, might have eternal life.*

ACT OF CONSECRATION TO THE IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY



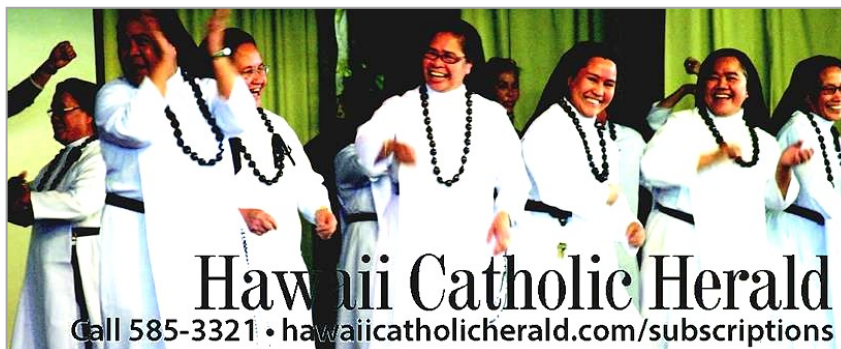
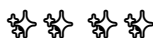
