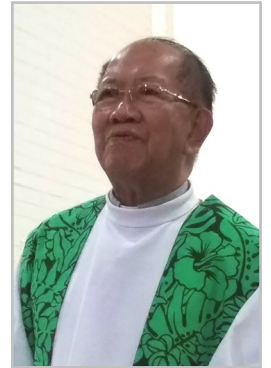

VIDEO PRESENTATIONS ON THE EUCHARIST

In keeping with the observance of the National Eucharistic Revival in the United States, there will be video presentations on the church teaching on the Eucharist on July 21 and August 11, both Fridays. They are informative and descriptive of the beauty and wonder of the Eucharist. We are inviting every parishioner to come and watch. We especially urge all liturgical ministers to attend because this will serve as their required spiritual recollection before the renewal of their commissioning during the weekend Masses of August 12-13. The topics for the video presentations are:

July 21 – #1 - "On the Road to Emmaus with Heart on Fire and Eyes Enlightened" by Dr. Tim Gray

August 11 – #2 - "Love Broken and Poured Out - Living a Eucharistic Life" by Dr. Mary Healy

"Let's be Eucharistic Stewards"



The second phase of the National Eucharistic Revival declared by the US Bishops Conference is the **Year of Parish Revival** which began on the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, June 11, 2023. On this new season of grace, Bishop Cozzens has composed a beautiful prayer for the Revival and the Church. At OLM, we shall pray together the Eucharistic Revival Prayer in all the Masses.

One of the fruits we anticipate from the National Eucharistic Revival movement is a greater unity within the Catholic Church. Let us join our brothers and sisters from all heritages and backgrounds in earnest intercession as we ask God to pour out an overflowing measure of grace and healing throughout the next year of this movement.

"**Eucharistic Stewardship**" is a prominent theme in the fifth chapter of the United States Catholic Bishops' pastoral letter *Stewardship: A Disciple's Response*. The bishops teach us that Catholics are called to make the Eucharist a priority in their communal life of prayer, worship and action. The bishops maintain that to be a follower of Jesus Christ one must be a

good steward of the Eucharist each and every day. Today, more than a quarter-century after the stewardship pastoral was written, the *International Catholic Stewardship Council* honors the bishops' teaching on Eucharistic stewardship at its 61st annual conference to be held from October 1-4, 2023 in Orlando, Florida.

OLM delegates participated the other week in the "**I Thirst**" *Hawaii Conference for Eucharistic Revival and Evangelization* which were conducted for clergy and laity by speakers from the US Mainland.

FOCUS: Jesus encourages us to persevere in faith even in challenging circumstances.

In our daily lives, it can be challenging to persevere in faith, in charity, and in kindness when dealing with people who appear to be the opposite – mean, vengeful, thoughtless. But Jesus reminds us that it is still possible to bear fruit under these conditions, and that even a small seed of faith can yield abundant fruit.

First Reading: *Wisdom 12:13, 16-19*

The author of the Book of Wisdom ponders the mystery of God's power, which he exercises with justice and leniency.

Second Reading: *Romans 8:26-27*

In the second reading, Paul describes how the Holy Spirit helps us pray.

Gospel: *Matthew 13:24-43*

In the Gospel, Jesus teaches his disciples about the kingdom of heaven through a series of parables.

STEWARDSHIP EXPRESSIONS

STEWARDSHIP OF LEISURE TIME: REFRESHING OUR SPIRITS

In a 2016 newspaper essay titled *In Defense of the Three-Week Vacation*, the writer makes the case for longer American respites from work. *Jynne Dilling* argues for trips that take us away from cell phone coverage and internet, and urges relaxation that includes reflective walks at dawn and time to get lost in a foreign habitat (New York Times, 9 June 2016). Many of us have neither the time nor the resources for long overseas sojourns, but all of us can resonate with the need to really “*get away*” from work or the daily grind or the constant demands of social media. Good stewardship of our bodies, minds and souls obliges us to get away on a regular basis (see Luke 5:16).



As Christian stewards, we aren’t just encouraged but obligated to consider how we approach our stewardship of leisure time. Stewards are aware of their need to be busy doing God’s work, but often forget that downtime is equally important to spiritual growth. Leisure time, whether it’s our evenings, our weekends, or our vacation, provides spiritual, physical, mental and emotional recharging. Leisure is necessary for human wholeness. Leisure reconnects us to the wider mysteries of our world and our God. It helps us daydream, imagine, pray. It refreshes our spirit.

Today, connectivity has become almost an obsession. People check their emails, their messages and calls with alarming repetitiveness. Accidents, both pedestrian and automobile, happen because people can’t put down their phones. Employers expect their workers to be available for evening emails. The lines between work and free time increasingly blur, as do the lines between solitude and always being present “*online*.” We can’t imagine putting aside screens for a two-week vacation. But we must give ourselves time to renew and recharge, not just two weeks of the year, but each day and each week.

July offers an opportunity to reconnect with the rhythms of God and nature. We need to take time off from screens and phones, and practice giving undivided attention to the things before us. When we pray, we commit time and silence. When we enjoy time with our friends and family, we practice being totally present. When we sit on the patio or at the beach, we give ourselves wholly to the wind or the waves. Be a good steward of your body, mind and soul. Don’t overschedule your time off. Listen to the quiet whisper of God encouraging you to relax.

The attached report now includes a column listing of parish assessments, which provides a broader picture of the parish commitment to the diocesan mission.

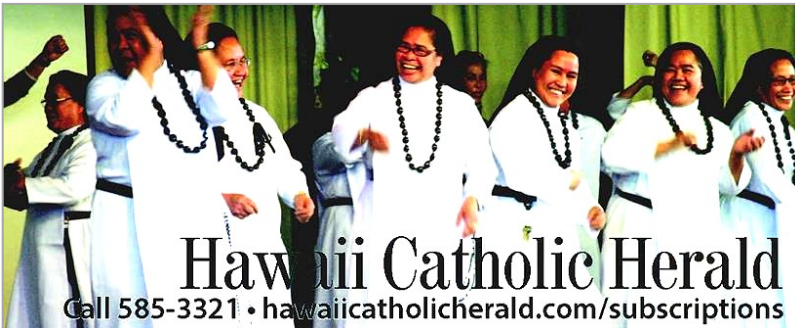

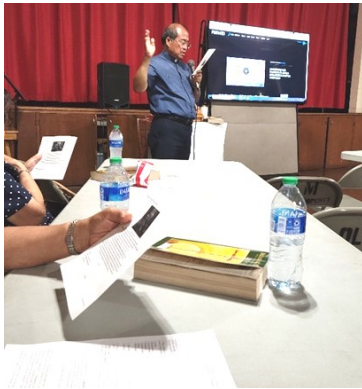
LITURGICAL MINISTERS RECOLLECTION

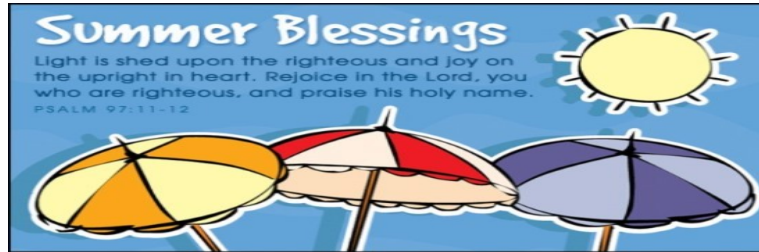
