






MOTHER'S DAY

We are excited about the possibility of Hawai'i having a third saint! St. Damien de Veuster was proclaimed a saint in 2009 and St. Marianne Cope was elevated to sainthood in 2012. The Servant of God Joseph Dutton, a layman worked with St. Damien and St. Marianne among the lepers in Moloka'i. He dedicated nearly 45 years of service living and suffering with those afflicted with Hansen's disease or leprosy in Kalaupapa, Moloka'i. Now his cause and process for beatification and canonization moves to the Vatican. This is a moment we can all be proud of as Catholics and residents of Hawai'i.

FOCUS: Remain in my love.

This Easter season, as the paschal mystery continues to unfold before us, Jesus focuses our attention on love being at the heart of discipleship. Jesus' words and actions were always rooted in his profound love for us. As disciples, we grow closer to Jesus and his mission by sharing God's love with others. In God's love, he is revealed.

In the first reading, Peter humbly speaks while the Holy Spirit falls upon those who are listening, resulting in more baptisms.

Second Reading: 1 John 4:7-10

In the second reading, John writes of our call to love one another.

Gospel: John 15:9-17

In the Gospel, Jesus tells his disciples to remain in his love. He calls them friends, no longer slaves.

STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

STEWARDSHIP: A WITNESS TO YOUNG PEOPLE

I have always found this excerpt from the U.S. bishops' pastoral letter, Stewardship: A Disciple's Response particularly powerful: "Jesus' call is urgent. He does not tell people to follow him at some time in the future but here and now — at this moment, in these circumstances. There can be no delay" (SDR, p. 14). As stewardship leaders, we must constantly ask ourselves these questions: What is our particular moment of life personally and in our faith community? What circumstances must we take into consideration as we call one another to live and grow as stewards, especially our young people?

In the first chapter of the bishops' letter, they help us to recognize that embracing stewardship is about living out our particular vocations and acting as compelling Christian witnesses to others. We discern Christ's call for us in the context of the community of believers; we respond to the urgent call of Christ. This is why it is very important that we begin forming our children and teens as stewards, so that they will recognize and respond to God's grace in their lives, understand themselves as disciples of Jesus Christ from a very early age, and reflect on their response to Christ's call and their many blessings as good stewards.

There is much evidence that such real-life, day-to-day faith formation is needed if our youth are to remain actively engaged in a life of faith within the faith community as young adults. In the United States over 30 percent of adults under the age of 30 are now unaffiliated. The majority of these young people leave their faith community before age 24. Young adults tell us they are looking for a meaningful way of life; they want to contribute to something that matters; they need to know that religion is not at odds with science, but rather, that faith brings a larger perspective to what is learned through science. They want and need to learn from the witness of adults who are actively living as faith-filled people in the world. Stewardship provides so much that our young people need. Forming young people to live as good stewards is a gift beyond what most of us can ask or imagine.

DIOCESE OF HONOLULU—EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL PILGRIMAGE STARTED ON NOVEMBER 1



HŌʻEUʻEU EUKALIKIA This Year of Parish Revival is about falling deeper in love with the Eucharistic Heart of Jesus and following him more closely. Mirroring this internal journey with an external one is a beautiful way to connect body and soul in the pursuit of Christ. Most of us will not have the opportunity to join the Eucharistic Caravan on the mainland leading to the Eucharistic Congress on July 17, 2024 in Indianapolis.

We can participate in the revival here at home. Make the Honolulu Diocese Pilgrimage a part of your experience of revival by planning a self-led personal pilgrimage in the next months leading up to the beginning of the Eucharistic Caravan in San Francisco.

The Diocese of Honolulu offers a Hawaii Eucharist Revival virtual pilgrimage called **Hawaii Pilgrim** or by getting the **Polarsteps - Travel Tracker app** for your digital device. Sign up for a free Polarsteps account. Enter "Hawaii Pilgrim" on the Explore (Search people & places) tab. Click on "Follow" and begin your journey. Use Hawaii Pilgrim to find church addresses, Mass, adoration and other regularly scheduled events when the church will be open.




