



Next Sunday's Reading

Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

First Reading Responsorial Psalm

Ezekiel 2:2-5 Psalm 123:1-4

Second Reading Gospel 2 Corinthians 12:7-10 Mark 6:1-6

FOCUS: Jesus gives us what we truly need.

When a woman who had spent all her money on doctors to no avail and a father whose daughter grew worse by the day turn to Jesus for help, Jesus doesn't question why they did not come to him first. Rather, he encourages the faith that led them to him and gives them what they need. We, too, can have faith that will lead us to seek Jesus' help, for he is ready to encourage us as well, and to give us what we most need.

First Reading: Wisdom 1:13-15, 2:23-24

The author of the Book of Wisdom explains that God formed man in his image to be *imperishable*, but through the work of the devil, *death entered the world*.

Second Reading: 2 Corinthians 8:7, 9, 13-15

Paul exhorts the Corinthians to be gracious and generous with their abundance, as Christ was to them.

Gospel: *Mark* 5:21-43

In the Gospel, Jesus heals a woman suffering from hemorrhages and raises a child from the dead.




FACILITIES REPAIR & MAINTENANCE

THE EUCHARISTIC CONGRESS is a gathering of the Church to bear witness to the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, which is an important Catholic doctrine. The Congress brings together people from a wide area and typically involves conversations, talks, and stories about the Eucharist.

In summary, the Eucharistic Congress will serve as a powerful moment for Catholics to come together, celebrate the Eucharist, and to strengthen their faith in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament.

The National Eucharistic Congress will be held in Indianapolis on July 15-19, 2024. Deacon Rafael Mendoza and other Hawaii delegates will attend.

*In implementing the Eucharistic Revival program, the Dioceses and parishes have their point persons. In the Diocese of Honolulu, it is Fr. Alfred Omar Guerrero and in OLM Parish, Fran Kovaloff is the point person. Fr. Ese'ese "Ace" Tui is the head of the Eucharistic Revival Task Force.
