

JULY 17-21, 2024



Watch the Opening of the National Eucharistic Congress on July 17 and all the events during the week on EWTN, Instagram, Facebook or YouTube.

THE EUCHARISTIC CONGRESS is a gathering of the Church to bear witness to the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, which is an important Catholic doctrine. The Congress brings together people from a wide area and typically involves conversations, talks, and stories about the Eucharist. In summary, the Eucharistic Congress will serve as a powerful moment for Catholics to come together, celebrate the Eucharist, and to strengthen their faith in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament.

The National Eucharistic Congress will be held in Indianapolis on July 17-21, 2024. *Deacon Rafael Mendoza* and other Hawaii delegates will attend.

FOCUS: God sends us on mission and provides us with the riches of his grace.

In the epistle, Paul writes that we are chosen and that God has blessed us in Christ with every

spiritual blessing.

Gospel: *Mark* 6:7-13

In the Gospel, Jesus sends the Twelve out two by two and instructs them to take nothing for their

journey.
