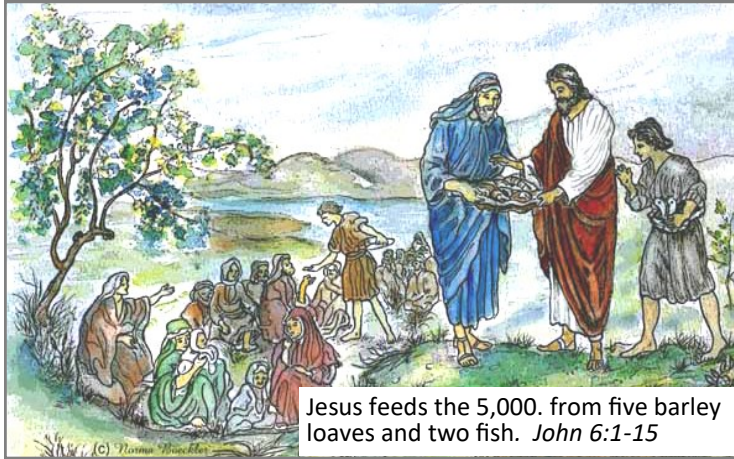

STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

BE GOOD STEWARDS OF YOUR FAMILY

July is the heart of summer, and summer is an exciting and challenging time for stewardship of the family. Everything turns a little upside down for the family in summer. Kids out of school, grandparents visiting, teens with a first job, road trips and those big family reunions: Sometimes it seems summer dashes by in a flurry of wet bathing suits and backyard barbecues. How does the Christian steward make summer a special time for "the domestic church" of family?

Relax!... No, really!... Relax! ... Slow down! The world often spins around us and we are caught up in work, social media, activity. Gift yourself and your family with time this summer. Be truly present. On one occasion, when Pope Francis addressed a homily to families, one word he used often was "simplicity." Make time for family meals, but make them simple and nutritious. "We need simplicity to pray as a family," the Holy Father said. Let each family member take a turn praying a simple grace at family meals. Linger over good food and good conversation. Make family your focus. Listen to your children. Take time for a night out with your spouse. Make a commitment to fun and presence.

The Holy Father also asked families, "How do we keep our faith as a family?" We don't keep it for ourselves, he said, "as a personal treasure like a bank account." No, we share it. We witness it. How can we witness faith during the summer months? "Christian families are missionary families," Pope Francis said. Summer is a good time to plan a field trip to a shelter or a food bank. Call ahead and ask what you can bring and how your family can help. Many agencies plan summer picnics and presentations by refugees during the season. Let your kids experience this diversity. Attend a vacation bible school or help with one. Invite a priest from your parish, or perhaps a lonely neighbor, to dinner. Spread your family joy.

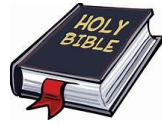
The summer readers in your family might benefit from finding Catholic periodicals or books on heroes of our faith. Visit new parishes during the summer. If you are on a road trip, never miss Sunday Mass and take advantage of a side trip to a shrine or an historic Catholic church. Most of all, relax and enjoy. Pope Francis says, "The family which experiences the joy of faith communicates it naturally."

Next Sunday's Reading Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

First Reading
Exodus 16:2-4, 12-15

Responsorial Psalm
Psalm 78:3-4, 23-25, 54

Second Reading
Ephesians 4:17, 20-24

Gospel
John 6:24-35

FOCUS: God provides for us.

Today's readings relate two feeding miracles – one performed by Elisha and one by Jesus. Of course, we know that the source of all miracles is God himself. In each story, the Lord goes beyond providing what is needed, multiplying what is offered so abundantly that there is food left over. As he provides for us, so we offer ourselves for him to use, and multiply what we offer, for others.

First Reading: *2 Kings 4:42-44*

In the first reading, Elisha feeds 100 people from 20 barley loaves and there is some left over.

Second Reading: *Ephesians 4:1-6*

Paul writes to the Ephesians encouraging them to live in a manner worthy of their call, with an emphasis on preserving unity.

Gospel: *John 6:1-15*

In the Gospel, Jesus feeds 5,000 from five barley loaves and two fish, and there are 12 baskets left over.

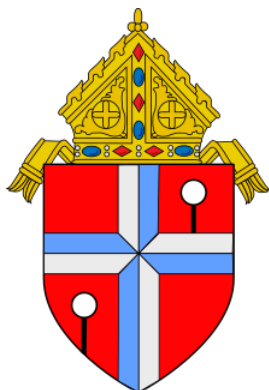

Topic: Making the Most of the Moments - Accompaniment and Evangelization through Moments of Return

Speaker: Mr. Paul Jarzembowski, Associate Director for the Laity for the Secretariat of Laity, Marriage, Family Life and Youth at the USCCB.

“It is important to make the most of the great moments of the liturgical year... Although we have to respect different stages of growth, and at times need to wait patiently for the right moment, we cannot fail to invite (all) people to drink from these

wellsprings of new life.” — Pope Francis (Apostolic Exhortation *Christus Vivit*, 2019, no. 224, 229)

We may know or have personally witnessed the trends of disconnection and distrust in religious institutions and church communities, but there is more to the story. While most people observe church attendance or affiliation declining year to year, there are unique anomalies in the data that can give us renewed hope. The month-to-month trends (and the wondrous occasions of “moments of return”) provide us with **a hopeful story**: one deserving of greater attention and exploration.

This session will guide participants and facilitate dialogue around unpacking “moments of return” throughout the year, such as Christmas, Ash Wednesday, Holy Week, and Easter, as well as weddings, baptisms, and funerals. We will also explore some less-obvious “moments” that reveal an overlooked abundance of occasions and opportunities upon which pastoral leaders, families, and concerned churchgoers can build. As Pope Francis notes, these “moments” can offer people “wellsprings of new life,” especially when we respond with intentionality, pastoral care, and a missionary spirit.

NATIONAL Eucharistic Revival



DIOCESE OF HONOLULU - EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL



The **TASK FORCE EVANGELIZATION IN HAWAII** headed by *Dominic Olaso* organized a mini-Eucharistic Congress at St. Pius X Church in Manoa on July 20 and at St. George Church, Waimanalo on July 21. Eight delegates from Our Lady of the Mount Church attended the presentations at St. George Church where the pastor, *Fr. Raymond Ellorin*, welcomed them. The presentations were done by the combination of *Peter Cruz*, a local Relic Custodian who talked about the “*Saints as Witnesses of the True Presence*” and by *Joe Melendrez*, a Catholic hip hop recording artist whose topic was “*Mission Driven*.” Through captivating stories on saints’ lives and energized music, the participants were drawn deeper into knowing and loving Jesus in the Eucharist. The speakers shared their faith in real and relatable ways using slideshows and movie clips that ushered the attendees into a journey of prayer, praise and worship. Some shots were taken and shared in this issue.

UPDATE: As we enter the third year of the National Eucharistic Revival, the US Bishops are asking every parish in the United States to participate in a kerygmatic preaching series for five weeks proclaiming Eucharistic theology in a special unified way. It will be based on the Sunday Gospel in John 6 about the Bread of Life discourse from July 28 to August 25.

*In implementing the Eucharistic Revival program, the Dioceses and parishes have their point persons. In the Diocese of Honolulu, it is *Fr. Al Guerrero* and in OLM Parish, *Fran Kovaloff* is the point person. *Fr. Ese'ese "Ace" Tui* is the head of the Eucharistic Revival Task Force.

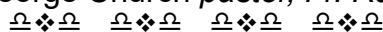

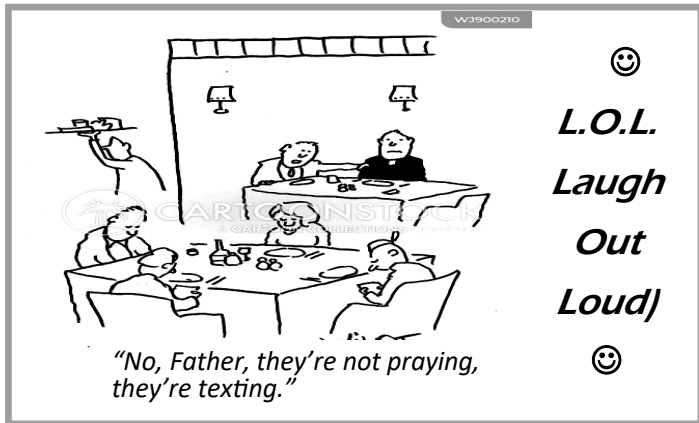
