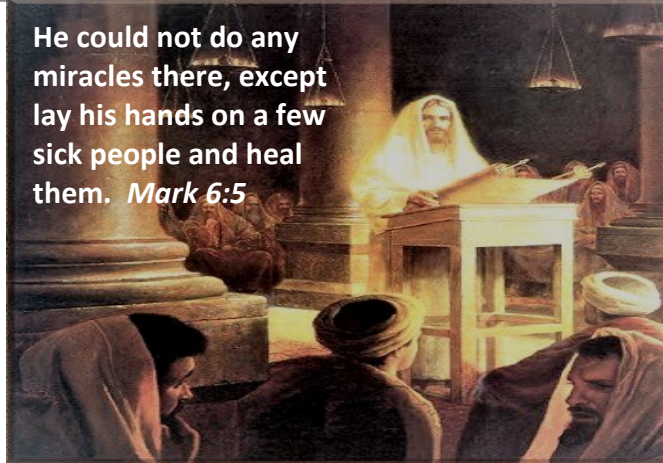

Pastor's Corner

Next Sunday's Reading Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

First Reading
Amos: 7:12-15

Responsorial Psalm
Psalm 85:9-14

Second Reading
Ephesians 1:3-14

Gospel
Mark 6:7-13

FOCUS: We are called to share our faith near and far.

In today's Gospel we find Jesus proclaiming the Good News in *his native place*. Although his message was not well received by most, there were a few who came to believe. We, too, are called to share our faith near and far. Sometimes our efforts will bear little fruit, but at other times, by God's grace, someone may come to faith and that possibility should encourage us to persevere in this endeavor.

First Reading: *Ezekiel 2:2-5*

The Lord sends Ezekiel to speak his word to the Israelites who have rebelled against God.

Second Reading: *2 Corinthians 12:7-10*

Paul shares how Christ's power is revealed through his own personal weaknesses.

Gospel: *Mark 6:1-6*

In the Gospel, Jesus is teaching in the synagogue in *his native place*, but is only able to perform a few healings because those who hear him do not believe.

THE EUCHARISTIC CONGRESS is a gathering of the Church to bear witness to the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, which is an important Catholic doctrine. The Congress brings together people from a wide area and typically involves conversations, talks, and stories about the Eucharist. In summary, the Eucharistic Congress will serve as a powerful moment for Catholics to come together, celebrate the Eucharist, and to strengthen their faith in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament.

The National Eucharistic Congress will be held in Indianapolis on July 15-19, 2024. Deacon Rafael Mendoza and other Hawaii delegates will attend.

*In implementing the Eucharistic Revival program, the Dioceses and parishes have their point persons. In the Diocese of Honolulu, it is Fr. Alfred Omar Guerrero and in OLM Parish, Fran Kovaloff is the point person. Fr. Ese'ese "Ace" Tui is the head of the Eucharistic Revival Task Force.

Come and spend some time with the Lord in church as a community to pray for peace in the world, for the end of the covid pandemic and for God's blessings on your home and family.

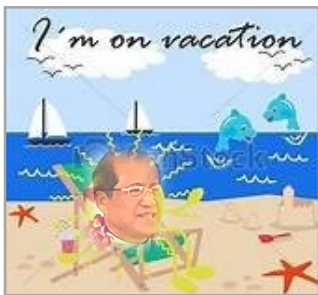

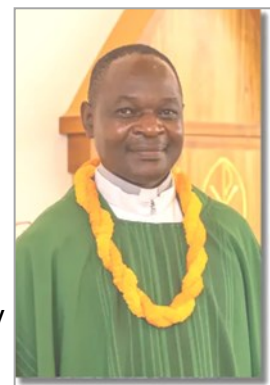

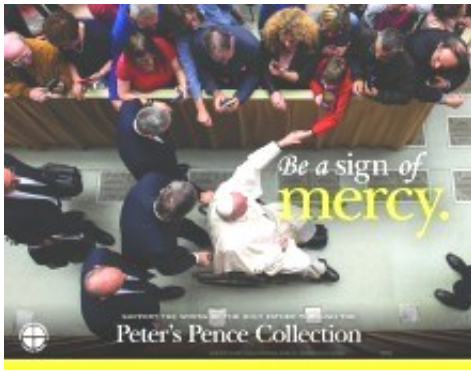

 We may enjoy fishing, swimming and barbecues.

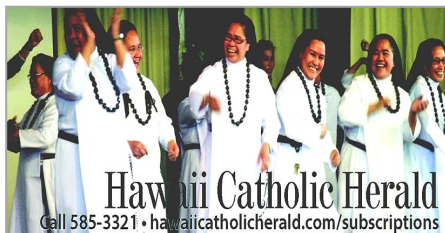
But whatever our summer opportunities,

FACILITIES REPAIR & MAINTENANCE

(Photos below): After the sealing of leaks and waterproofing of the main parish hall roofing by *Adriano Daligcon* and *Carlito Centino*, *Rudy Fiesta* followed it up with filling and fixing the cracks on the concrete canopy over the hall kitchen exterior. Adriano Daligcon continued to install the smoke alarms. He also fixed the Women's Toilet lavatory and swing door. All these structural repairs and improvements are supervised by Roger Isidro. *Kalolo Tuihalafatai* provided ropes and body security straps for safety precautions. 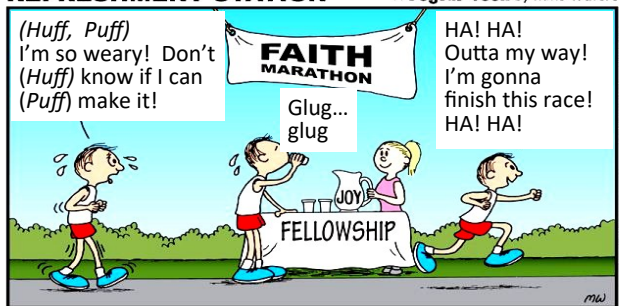

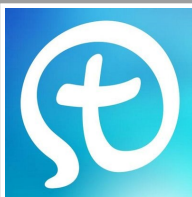
