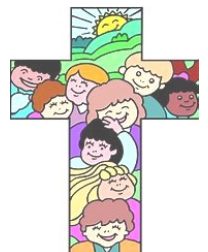

Pastor's Corner

Next Sunday's Reading Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

First Reading
1 Kings 19:4-8

Responsorial Psalm
Psalm 34:2-9

Second Reading
Ephesians 4:30-5:2

Gospel
John 6:41-51

FOCUS: The Lord never fails us, providing for our every need.

The people expected, and trusted, that God would provide for their every need ... except when they didn't. The Lord expected that his people would obey his commands and follow his guidance ... except they often didn't. Notice who fails in this relationship: it's not God! God provided daily bread to sustain them in the desert. He provides for us the true bread of life – Jesus – to sustain us for eternity. The Lord never fails us, providing for our every need.

First Reading: *Exodus 16:2-4, 12-15*

In the first reading, God feeds his people bread from heaven to sustain them in the desert.

Second Reading: *Ephesians 4:17, 20-24*

Paul exhorts the Ephesians to put on their new selves in Christ.

Gospel: *John 6:24-35*

In the Gospel, a few verses after feeding the crowd loaves and fishes, Jesus shares God's offer of true bread that endures for eternal life, that is, Jesus himself.



HAPPY 75TH BIRTHDAY, BISHOP LARRY! > August 6

Reflecting on "One Ohana"

July 29, 2024 > *From the Office for Social Ministry*

"God himself is a community, that perfect community of love, three persons in one God and that is what we are called to be. We are never to be alone. We know that we are part of an Ohana — that God is always a part of that family. God is always the One who calls us into that family." (Bishop Larry Silva, from the *One Ohana* video series on the Sacraments).

Bishop Larry Silva's 75th birthday on August 6 provides an opportunity to reflect upon his years of loving service witnessing to Jesus in the Diocese of Honolulu. Over the last decade, the Office for Social Ministry has been blessed to participate in the production of the diocese's award-winning "*One Ohana*" video series on the sacraments, which expressed some of Bishop Larry's inspiring pastoral reflections.

The first of the "*One Ohana*" videos featured the sacrament of Baptism, in which Bishop Larry eloquently lifted up the vital connection of faith and family. He compared the joyful gift of a child's birth to the experience of God's beauty. Baptism is the initial way in which God envelops us in His love and we are welcomed into the Catholic community, an Ohana of aloha.

The second video of the series focused on the sacrament of the Eucharist, which Bishop Larry identified as central to the Catholic faith. *"While Baptism is the first sacrament of initiation, the Eucharist is truly the source of from which all sacraments flow. The celebration of the Eucharist in a Mass is where we often begin our journey of faith on earth, first in baptism and ended in a funeral. During our lives we often celebrate other sacraments like confirmation, marriage, holy orders and even anointing in the celebration of the Eucharist."*

In the video, Bishop Larry reminds all that the literal meaning of the Eucharist is to give thanks *"and what we give thanks for mostly is the fact that God loves us so much that he sent his Son. So let us do these things in memory of Jesus. Let us be bread broken and wine poured out as one Ohana, witness to Jesus by sharing all the wonderful blessings that God has given us."* As we celebrate Bishop Larry's 75th birthday, let us as one Ohana give thanks for God's blessing of Bishop Larry's loving presence and his calling all to witness to Jesus. *Mahalo!*

STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

CALLED TO BE SAINTS

(Theme for the 62nd ICSC Annual Conference)

Stewardship means saying “Yes” to God in our homes, parishes, communities and beyond. We are called to share the gifts we have been given to bring about the kingdom of God. We are called to holiness. And as Saint Paul reminded the early Christian community at Corinth, we are “Called to be Saints.” The theme for this year’s ICSC conference is Called to be Saints, which was an expression used by Saint Paul in his first letter to that Christian community at Corinth. This expression, Called to be Saints, reminds us to be good stewards of our life of faith in Christ Jesus. The 2024 ICSC Stewardship Conference offers its members and other attendees a chance to gather and reflect on stewardship in the Catholic Church and how it is an integral part of our faith.

This year, ICSC adopts as its conference image the classical painting Adoration of the Holy Trinity by Albrecht Dürer, ca. 1511. The painting gives us the opportunity to see a dazzling vision of the kingdom of heaven from two perspectives. We see both heaven and earth which keeps us mindful that though we live on this earth, we are as Saint Paul describes in his letter to the Corinthians, counted among the saints in heaven through our Baptism and profession of faith in our Triune God.

Internationally recognized as the most valuable conference for those involved in Christian stewardship, the annual ICSC conference is a gathering of scores of Catholic stewards living and teaching Christian stewardship in the Catholic tradition. It offers nearly 90 program sessions to inform and inspire attendees through the sharing of innovative ideas, networking with peers, and providing best practices and proven strategies for inviting others in parishes and dioceses alike to become good stewards of their life in Christ. UPDATE: As we enter the third year of the National Eucharistic Revival, the US Bishops are asking every parish in the United States to participate in a kerygmatic preaching series for five weeks proclaiming Eucharistic theology in a special unified way. It will be based on the Sunday Gospel in John 6 about the Bread of Life discourse from July 28 to August 25.

*In implementing the Eucharistic Revival program, the Dioceses and *parishes* have their point persons. In the Diocese of Honolulu, it is *Fr. Alfred Omar Guerrero* and in OLM Parish, *Fran Kovaloff* is the point person. *Fr. Ese'ese "Ace" Tui* is the head of the Eucharistic Revival Task Force.

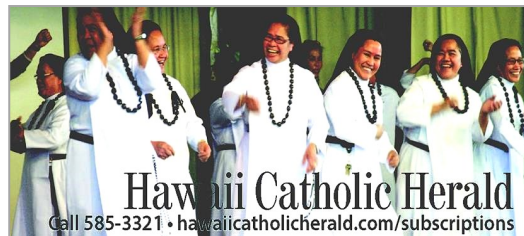

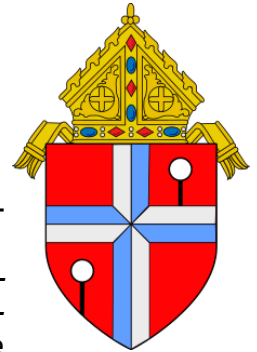
Topic: Making the Most of the Moments - Accompaniment and Evangelization through Moments of Return

Speaker: Mr. Paul Jarzembowski, Associate Director for the Laity for the Secretariat of Laity, Marriage, Family Life and Youth at the USCCB.

"It is important to make the most of the great moments of the liturgical year... Although we have to respect different stages of growth, and at times need to wait patiently for the right moment, we cannot fail to invite (all) people to drink from these wellsprings of new life." — Pope Francis (Apostolic Exhortation *Christus Vivit*, 2019, no. 224, 229)

We may know or have personally witnessed the trends of disconnection and distrust in religious institutions and church communities, but there is more to the story. While most people observe church attendance or affiliation declining year to year, there are unique anomalies in the data that can give us renewed hope. The month-to-month trends (and the wondrous occasions of "moments of return") provide us with **a hopeful story**: one deserving of greater attention and exploration.

This session will guide participants and facilitate dialogue around unpacking "moments of return" throughout the year, such as Christmas, Ash Wednesday, Holy Week, and Easter, as well as weddings, baptisms, and funerals. We will also explore some less-obvious "moments" that reveal an overlooked abundance of occasions and opportunities upon which pastoral leaders, families, and concerned churchgoers can build. As Pope Francis notes, these "moments" can offer people "wellsprings of new life," especially when we respond with intentionality, pastoral care, and a missionary spirit.
