



# Pastor's Corner

#### **Next Sunday's Reading**

Thirty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

First Reading

Psalm 16:5, 8-11

Daniel 12:1-3

Gospel

Second Reading

Hebrews: 10:11-14, 18

Mark 13:24-32

**FOCUS:** God calls us to give all we have, putting our trust in him.

Our readings today feature two widows who teach us about faithfulness. To have faith is not just to hold our breath and aimlessly wish for good outcomes. Rather, God calls us to a faith that is endless trust in him, knowing in our deepest heart that God loves and cares for us beyond measure.

First Reading: 1 Kings 17:10-16

Elijah goes to Zarephath, where he asks a widow for water and bread. She brings him the water but tells him she does not have much left for bread. He tells her to not be afraid and that her supply will not go empty.

Second Reading: Hebrews 9:24-28

In the second reading, the author writes that Christ appear[ed] before God on our behalf.

**Gospel:** *Mark* 12:38-44

In the Gospel, Jesus observes a widow contribute to the treasury and teaches his disciples that her gift is worth far more than the gifts of the rich.

#### STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

#### LET'S SHOW GRATITUDE FOR OUR PARISH FAMILY

During the month of November let us remember to include our parish family when we express gratitude for the abundant gifts we have been given. Our parish families are great blessings because they are signs of Christ's active presence in the world today. Saint John Paul II once described a parish as a "family of families." If we accept that the parish is a family, then surely it takes on the characteristics of a family. And just like a family, the gifts of the Holy Spirit to our parishes include the many different talents and temperaments we find in the pews, parish house and parking lot. They become great strengths when we are united in building up the Body of Christ. The mission of our parish is to continue the saving work of Jesus Christ, who expressed his own ministry resolutely: "I must proclaim the Kingdom of God" (Lk 4:43). The



parish is a steward of this ongoing ministry, and as members of a parish family we too are stewards of Christ's work. That is why it is so important to be nourished by the Eucharist regularly and to participate fully in the great prophetic witness of the parish: to offer our time, assist in one or more of the many parish ministries, invite others into our parish life of faith, carry our share of the financial responsibility for the parish and celebrate when our parish family celebrates. Remember as well our pastors and those other priests and pastoral professionals who seek to nourish us with the Bread of Life and to help us understand more fully our faith and the actions which spring from that faith. The life of faith we experience in our parishes is not perfect. What family is perfect? Our parish family never has been and never will be perfect because we are not perfect. But part of what we share in our parish is Christ's love, which is perfect. The love that we share is a gospel that has been given to us to live and proclaim in word and deed. It is a gospel that gives us hope. And for that, we should be grateful.


