
Second Reading: Hebrews: 10:11-14, 18

Find one nearby and experience something new and enriching. • Help someone if you can. Extend your generosity and blessings beyond your own family. Be part of an adopt-a-family effort, help distribute food baskets, or bring canned foods or clothing to St. Vincent de Paul centers.

• Take a walk. Find a place to enjoy God's gift of creation. Head out the door for a refreshing walk. Invite family, friends or others to share the experience too.

• Most important! Take advantage of the Thanksgiving holidays to focus on what you're grateful for and the things you appreciate about yourself and others. It is an ideal time to remember and to celebrate the many blessings in our lives.







DCFCC CONVENTION

The 74th Convention of the DCFCC (Diocesan Congress of Filipino Catholic Clubs) was held on November 8-10, 2024 at the Hilo Hawaiian Hotel. Around 200 delegates from the Councils of Kauai, Oahu, Maui and Big Island comprising more or less 40 parish units were in attendance. They included priests, deacons and nuns who are the units' Spiritual Directors – *Fr. Eric Castro, MSS* of St. Joseph Waipahu; *Fr. Arnel Soriano* of Annunciation Parish, Waimea; *Fr. Ferdinand Tomo, SSS* of St. Joseph, Hilo; *Fr. Falaniko Atonio* of Malia Pula O Kalani, Keaukaha, Hilo; *Sr. Rosalinda Barrozo, MM*, DCFCC Co-Spiritual Director; *Sr. Ursolina* and *Sr. Olivia*, both Missionaries of Faith; and *Deacon Andy Ragasa* of St. Catherine Parish in Kapaa, Kauai. Among the Oahu delegates were the OLM FCC officers and members led by *Fe Go, Norma Daligcon, Aida Isidro, Olivia Mita, Teresa Siruno, Beth Pisbe* and *Adriano Daligcon*. OLM Pastor, *Fr. Edgar Brillantes*, attended as Spiritual Director of the DCFCC.

The convention was a combination of the celebration of the Holy Mass, devotional praying of the Rosary and Chaplet of Divine Mercy, keynote speech, workshops, Administrative Board and Membership business meetings and socials.
