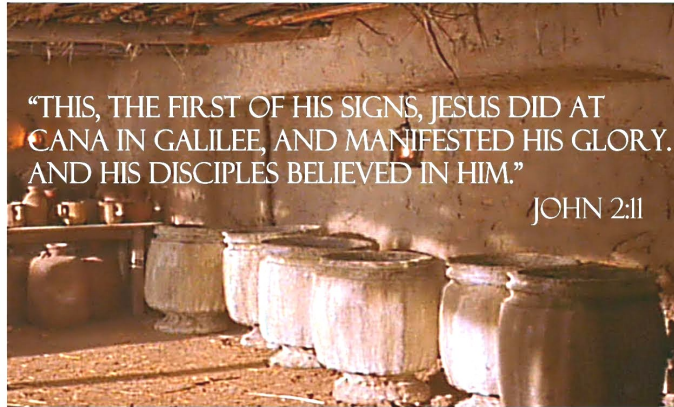

JUBILEE YEAR 2025



THEME: “PILGRIMS OF HOPE”

Hope is an important hallmark of the Catholic Church mission to share the light of God’s love through encountering Christ with others, especially those experiencing difficult situations. The Pope said: *“To hope is to welcome this gift that God offers us every day to savor the wonder of being loved, sought, desired by a God who has made Himself flesh and blood, history and days, to share our lot. Hope is also a task that Christians have a duty to cultivate and put to good use for the sake of all their brothers and sisters.”*

Pope Francis emphasizes that the Jubilee Year 2025 calls Christians to be living “*signs of hope*” through compassionate actions including becoming closer pastorally to all people “*in difficult situations.*” In his Jubilee message, he lovingly echoes his 2023 Christmas message to marginalized individuals: *“Christ is born for you! Rejoice, you who have abandoned all hope, for God offers you His outstretched hand. He does not point a finger at you but offers you His little baby hand, in order to set you free from your fears, to relieve you of your burdens, and to show you that, in His eyes, you are more valuable than anything else.”*

The Jubilee 2025 officially began on Christmas Eve, with the opening of the Holy Door at St. Peter’s Basilica in the Vatican before the pope celebrated midnight Mass.

Pope Francis’ prayer: *“May the grace of the Jubilee reawaken in us, Pilgrims of Hope, to spread the joy and peace of our Redeemer throughout the earth. Amen.”* We are praying at OLM the Jubilee Prayer at the end of all the weekend Masses.

FOCUS: The Lord's love and care for us knows no bounds.

It is comforting to know that, within the kingdom of God, all will be well in the end. Isaiah tells us of God's promise to Zion – which we know to be fulfilled in his Son, Jesus. And Jesus, whose ministry on earth was visible and transformative, takes care to ensure that the wedding feast is not spoiled while demonstrating that what he offers us is superior to anything the world may offer. God's care for us knows no bounds, and the goodness we experience here is but a taste of what is to come.

First Reading: *Isaiah 62:1-5*

In the first reading, Isaiah speaks of God's care for Zion, and his promise of restoration and rejoicing. Zion will be like a cherished bride.

Second Reading: *1 Corinthians 12:4-11*

In the second reading, Paul writes of the same Spirit producing different individual gifts.

Gospel: *John 2:1-11*

In the Gospel, Jesus attends a wedding feast at Cana and the *wine [runs] short*. He instructs the servers to fill jars with water, and when the water is drawn out to be tasted, it had become wine.

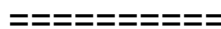

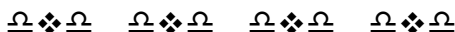

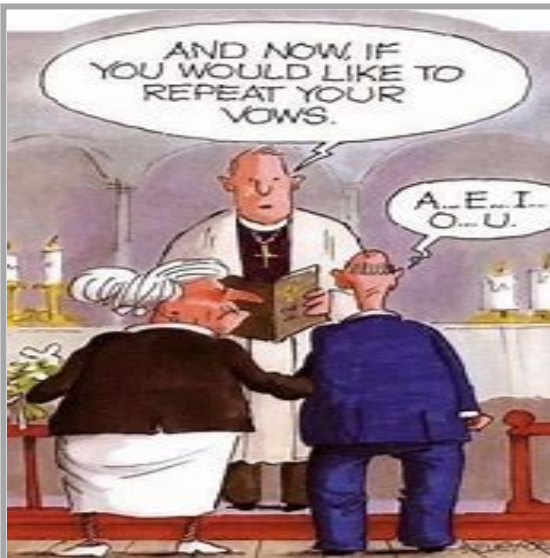
