# Pastor's Corner

## Next Sunday's Reading

The Presentation of the Lord

First Reading Responsorial Psalm

Malachi 3:1-4 Psalm 24:7-10

Second Reading Gospel

Hebrews 2:14-18 Luke 2:22-40

**FOCUS**: Rejoicing in the Lord must be your strength.

The priest-scribe Ezra proclaims the law of Moses to the Jewish people who had returned from exile in Babylon. Upon hearing the words of the law for the first time in a generation, the people weep. Their sorrow at not having adhered to the law for so long should call attention to our own infidelities to God's law. But most of all, this people's wholehearted response to the law can fill us with gratitude to God for revealing his merciful love to us in Jesus Christ.

First Reading: Nehemiah 8:2-4, 5-6, 8-10

In the first reading, Ezra the priest-scribe reads from the book of the law, interpreting so that all could understand. He enjoins them, *Today is holy to the Lord your God. Do not be sad, and do not weep*.

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 12:12-30

In the second reading, Paul writes that, in Christ, all are one body. Each part of the body has a purpose to fulfill.

Gospel: Luke 1:1-4, 4:14-21

In the Gospel, Jesus returns to Nazareth. There he reads in the synagogue and announces that the passage is fulfilled in their hearing.

# **JUBILEE YEAR 2025**

THEME: "PILGRIMS OF HOPE"



Hope is an important hallmark of the Catholic Church mission to share the light of God's love through encountering Christ with others, especially those experiencing difficult situations. The Pope said: "To hope is to welcome this gift that God offers us every day to savor the wonder of being loved, sought, desired by a God who has made Himself flesh and blood, history and days, to share our lot. Hope is also a task that Christians have a duty to cultivate and put to good use for the sake of all their brothers and sisters."

Pope Francis emphasizes that the Jubilee Year 2025 calls Christians to be living "signs of hope" through compassionate actions including becoming closer pasto-

rally to all people "in difficult situations." In his Jubilee message, he lovingly echoes his 2023 Christmas message to marginalized individuals: "Christ is born for you! Rejoice, you who have abandoned all hope, for God offers you His outstretched hand. He does not point a finger at you but offers you His little baby hand, in order to set you free from your fears, to relieve you of your burdens, and to show you that, in His eyes, you are more valuable than anything else."

The Jubilee 2025 officially began on Christmas Eve, with the opening of the Holy Door at St. Peter's Basilica in the Vatican before the pope celebrated midnight Mass.

Pope Francis' prayer: "May the grace of the Jubilee reawaken in us, Pilgrims of Hope, to spread the joy and peace of our Redeemer throughout the earth. Amen." We are praying at OLM the Jubilee Prayer at the end of all the weekend Masses.



# OM 155TH PARISHAMNYARSARY



During the Jubilee Year 2025, we also mark at OLM the 155<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the foundation of our parish. With God's grace, we look forward to celebrate the milestone with various festivities lined up every month until the grand celebration in August 15 and 17 which is also our patroness' feast day.

In the month of January we were able to jumpstart our monthly celebration of our Parish Anniversary with the feast of the Infant Jesus, popularly known as Santo Nino. Through the leadership of the Santo Nino de Cebu of Honolulu, the parish had a grand and solen time of celebrating the Holy Mass, with Bishop Larry Silva presiding and concelebrated by 4 priests and 1 deacon. A procession was made around the church followed

by the traditional sinulog dance with the image of the Santo Nino and to the rhythm of the drumbeats.

For this coming month, we shall focus on celebrating marriage and family life. In sync with the secular observance of February 14 as Valentine's Day for lovers we are honoring married couples and extolling the beauty and joy of living family life in harmony. The Jubilee Committee is hoping that the Knights of Columbus will coordinate this celebration since one of their Faith in Action programs is to promote family life with their ongoing drive of selecting Family of the Month honoree. The Pastoral Council and other ministries are welcomed to assist.


