FOCUS: The sting of death has been banished by the victory of Christ.

In the second reading we heard that death is no longer something to be feared, for it has been *swallowed up* by the victory of Christ: *Where, O death, is your sting?* Jesus' life, death, and resurrection have transformed death into the road to eternal life. Therefore, in this life, we must labor with the steadfast hope of attaining heaven, certain that if we strive to serve the Lord our work is not in vain.

First Reading: Sirach 27:4-7

Today's first reading warns of the power of speech to reveal one's faults.

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 15:54-58

In the second reading, Paul explains that Jesus has defeated sin, the cause of death.

Gospel: *Luke* 6:39-45

In the Gospel, Jesus tells his disciples to stop judging others, and says that every tree is known by

its own fruit.

After the Parish Building & Maintenance Committee chose the winning bids for the A/C installation and electrical work, hopefully the factory-ordered A/C units will be installed as soon as they arrive. *Ray Fontanilla* of A/I Refrigeration & Air Conditioning Services will do the installation of the A/C units. Ray is an OLM parishioner. *Remar Aguino* of Remar Electric will do the electrical work.

Soon after the Parish Finance Chair, *Kathy Ferreira*, made an appeal to parishioners to support the project, generous donors immediately responded. We continue to appeal to every parishioner to pitch in whatever you can give from the magnanimity of your heart. Big or small amounts are surely appreciated and accepted.

This project came up as a felt-need because of the rising temperature and humidity. We certainly want to feel comfortable when we are in church worshipping and celebrating the sacred liturgy. They will supplement the existing wall fans when it gets exceptionally hot and humid. So, they are switched on only as needed, and when that happens they also help reduce the noise outside because we have to shut off the jalousie windows and doors. We earnestly ask your monetary support for this project, and we also ask your prayers that this project may be realized in time for the celebration of our parish 155th anniversary.



"CELEBRATING MARRIAGE & FAMILY LIFE" *HONORING COUPLES AS LOVING PARENTS & GRANDPARENTS* FEBRUARY 23, 2025 – 4:00 PM

The February celebration of our Parish 155th Anniversary was focused on honoring married couples. It coincided with the observance of World Marriage Day and Valentine's Day in the love-month of February. The "Marriage & Family Life" event was meant to honor and recognize couples for keeping their matrimonial promises to love and remain faithful to one another and for being loving parents and grandparents to their families. The Letter to the Hebrews declares: "Let marriage be held in honor by all" (Heb 13:4).

The program consisted of praying the holy rosary, renewal of marriage vows, reception, entertainment and social dancing. The rosary was led by the OLM Knights of Columbus Council 12935. It was followed by the keynote presentation of the husband-wife team of Deacon Rafael & Ma. Sophia Mendoza who spoke about "The Joys & Challenges of Married Life". The highlight was the solemn Renewal of Marriage Vows by the couples presided by our Pastor, Fr. Edgar which included a Prayer of Blessing for Families and floral offering to the Blessed Mother Mary. A champagne toast for the renewed couples was proposed by KoC Grand Knight Herman Monico followed by the cutting of the cake by each couple. The couples then filled up the dance floor as Segundo Facuri belted out the Hawaiian Wedding Song on his ukulele. The dinner reception was served while the entertainment was provided by George Roberts on his guitar, the guest performers Siegrid & EJ delos Reyes, Florencio Sipalay and the Knights' karaoke singing. There were also interspersed raffle draws with prizes given away. An inspirational message was delivered by Fr. Melchor Palomares, a clergy of the Diocese of Laoag and capped it with his rendition of the OPM "Ngayon at Kailanman." The Knights of Columbus thru Grand Knight Herman Monico awarded the "Family of the Month" Recognition to the couple Florencio & Rosario Sipalay. Judges came up also with the results of the "Couples of the Night" competition. The winners were - Alex & Marichu Pe Benito, Roger & Aida Isidro and Juriz & Fe Go.

The event was made truly joyful and memorable by the presence of 38 couples and thru the coordination and support of the Knights of Columbus OLM Council 12935, Pastoral Council, parish committees, ministries, organizations & staff under the auspices of the Parish Anniversary committee. We thank the generous donors of the food and drinks, the flowers and decorations, the door prizes and awards for the Couples of the Night and Family of the Month. Mr. & Mrs. William & Mitronia Amoroso who came as the oldest couple were even moved to donate \$1,000-check to the OLM Knights of Columbus. We also appreciate the blessed singles, the widows and married ones without spouses who by their mere presence, donations and services during the event manifested their joyful support to the couples. For all their love and sacrifices for their families and for our Church, the married couples deserve all the honors and we hope that they also get motivated to encourage their children, grandchildren and young people to come to Church with them and attend Mass, join the Catechism classes and Youth Ministry program and receive the other Initiation Sacraments of Confirmation and First Communion. When we care for the children and young people and nurture them in the faith we can look forward to a bright and vibrant future for our Church. In Jesus' name, Amen.


