Acts of the Apostles
10:34, 37-43

FOCUS: .Because Christ humbled himself, God greatly exalted him.

Luke's Gospel emphasizes the need for disciples of Christ to follow in his footsteps, as Jesus tells the Apostles that he is among them *as the one who serves*. Like the servant of the Lord who is spoken of in the reading from the prophet Isaiah, Christ does not refuse his calling. He willingly submits to suffering for our sake. Following Christ's example, it is through humble service to one another that we will be exalted.

Jesus proceeds to Jerusalem, where he is welcomed as a king with shouts of joy praising God for his mighty deeds.

First Reading: *Luke 19:28-40*

In the first reading, Isaiah prophesies of one who does not shield his face from buffets or spitting, knowing he will not be put to shame.

Scnd Reading: *Philippians 2:6-11*

Paul writes that Christ humbled himself, becoming obedient to the point of death on a cross.

Gospel: *Luke 22:14-23:56*

In the Gospel, Jesus celebrates Passover with his friends, speaks of his imminent betrayal, and after hours of interrogation and torture, is handed over to be crucified.

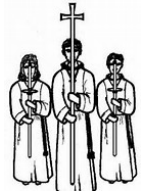

JUBILEE YEAR 2025**THEME: "PILGRIMS OF HOPE"**

On the opening of the Jubilee Year 2025 Pope Francis calls Christians to be living "*signs of hope*" through compassionate actions including becoming closer pastorally to all people "*in difficult situations.*" In his Jubilee message, the Pope declared: "*Christ is born for you! Rejoice, you who have abandoned all hope, for God offers you His outstretched hand. He does not point a finger at you but offers you His little baby hand, in order to set you free from your fears, to relieve you of your burdens, and to show you that, in His eyes, you are more valuable than anything else.*"

We are praying the Jubilee Prayer at the end of all the weekend Masses.



OLM 155TH PARISH ANNIVERSARY

During the Jubilee Year 2025, we also mark the 155th Anniversary of the foundation of our parish. With joy and God's grace, we look forward to celebrate the milestone with various festivities lined up every month until the grand celebration in August 15 and 17 which is also our patroness' feast day. In the month of January, we jumpstarted our monthly celebration with the feast of the Infant Jesus, popularly known as *Santo Nino*.

For the month of February, the focus was on celebrating marriage and family life. In sync with the secular observance of February 14 as Valentine's Day for lovers we honored married couples and extolled the beauty and joy of living family life in harmony.

For March, we focus on spirituality by holding a Lenten Parish Mission aside from the Friday Stations of the Cross and Penance Service.

As we solemnly commemorate our parish anniversary, we earnestly ask for your spiritual and moral support. May the Lord continue to bless our common mission and efforts to communicate Christ and convey hope, encouragement and inspiration to everyone. STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

ALMSGIVING IS PUTTING PRAYER INTO ACTION

As our Lenten journey brings us closer to Easter, let's be mindful of those ancient and time-tested exercises that help us renew our lives and bring us closer to God. The traditional practices include: prayer, fasting and almsgiving.

Lent, of course, is a privileged period for prayer and many spiritual writers have encouraged us to see fasting and almsgiving as essential elements of our prayer lives. St Augustine wrote that fasting and almsgiving are *"the two wings of prayer"* and that almsgiving is actually putting our prayer into action.

Of course, much attention is paid to prayer and fasting. But almsgiving gets the least attention among the three Lenten practices. Almsgiving can actually be viewed as *"fasting"* from our income and material possessions. It also brings us closer to Christ Jesus because it translates our prayers into acts of love for each other and for those less fortunate. The New Testament reveals how the early Christians embraced the practice of almsgiving. For Saint Luke, almsgiving was essential to the practice of good stewardship. St. James exhorts Christians to care for the needs of their brothers or sisters, to put their faith into action with alms to those in need:

If a brother or sister is poorly clothed and in lack of daily food, and one of you says to them, 'Go in peace, be warmed and filled,' without giving them the things needed for the body, what does it profit? So faith, by itself, if it has no works, is dead (2:15-17).

Almsgiving is about showing our love through sharing rather than hoarding what we have and Lent is perhaps one of the best times of the year to prayerfully discern how best we can act with generosity toward others. We might even try creating an Almsgiving Plan to help us prayerfully discern how best to organize our giving. Take some quiet moments to prayerfully reflect on what you have to share and write down a giving plan that includes your parish, diocese, and charities that could use your financial support.

Easter is almost upon us. Let us act now to integrate almsgiving into our life of faith. By putting our prayer into action in this way, we begin to "cast off" the old self within us and put on Christ in order to arrive at Easter renewed and able to say, with St. Paul: "It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me."

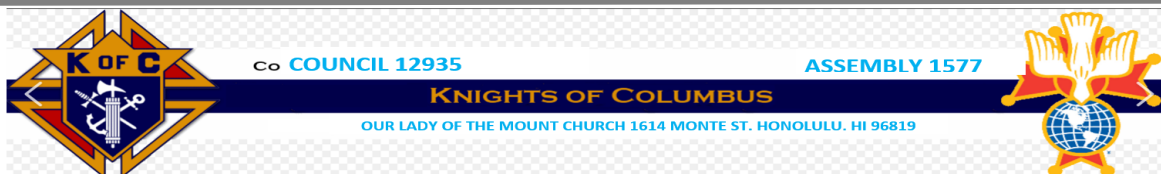

- * Turn in your gifts on Holy Thursday in the baskets that will be provided.

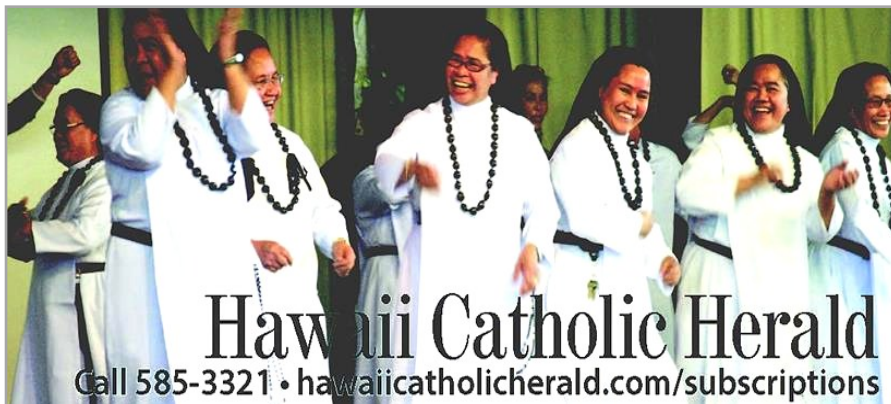

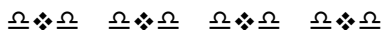

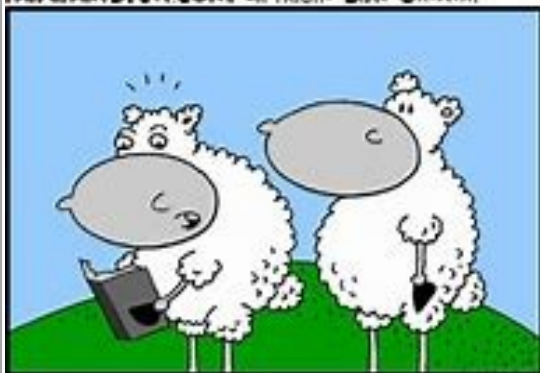
