FOCUS: Stand firm in faith.

This season of Lent prepares us for Easter, when we will celebrate the Lord's resurrection. In today's Gospel Peter, John, and James get a glimpse of Jesus' glorified body. This is the type of body that Paul tells the Philippians we will one day have, as long as we stand firm in our faith – not only in Christ's resurrection, but also in his cross.

First Reading: Genesis 15:5-12, 17-18

In the first reading, God makes a covenant with Abram, promising descendants as numerous as the stars and land for them to inhabit.

## Second Reading: Philippians 3:17-4.1

Paul tells the Philippians to imitate him, conducting themselves not as enemies of the cross, but standing firm in the Lord.

Gospel: Luke 9:28-36

In the Gospel, Jesus is transfigured on the mountain; Moses and Elijah appear with him in glory.

We are praying the Jubilee Prayer at the end of all the weekend Masses.



## STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION STEWARDSHIP SAINT FOR MARCH: SAINT JOSEPH



Next to the Blessed Virgin Mary, Saint Joseph is the most honored saint in the Catholic Church for being the foster father of Jesus and the husband of Mary. His traditional feast day is March 19.

Joseph's life is depicted in the gospels, particularly in Matthew and Luke. He was born in Bethlehem and is described as being a descendant of King David.

Mary was betrothed to Joseph, but was pregnant with the Christ child before Joseph took her into his home. According to Jewish law at the time, Mary could have been stoned to death if she was believed to have been unfaithful to her betrothed. An angel of the Lord told Joseph to take Mary into his home, that the child was conceived through the Holy Spirit, and that his name would be Jesus.

After Jesus' birth at Bethlehem, in yet another dream, Joseph was told to take Mary and Jesus to Egypt and remain there until Herod's slaughter of newborns had come to an end with Herod's own death. Joseph, Mary, and Jesus returned to the region of Galilee and settled in Nazareth where Joseph taught his craft of carpentry to Jesus. Joseph is last mentioned in the Gospels when, on their pilgrimage to Jerusalem, he and Mary frantically searched for the lost Jesus in Jerusalem, and found him in the Temple (Luke 2:42–52).

Saint Joseph was declared patron saint and protector of the universal Church by Pope Pius IX at the close of the First Vatican Council in 1870. He is also considered a spiritual model for families and Christian teaching frequently stresses his patience, persistence, and hard work as admirable qualities Christians should reflect upon and embrace. He is the patron saint of fathers, foster fathers, husbands, the unborn, working people in general and social justice.

Saint Joseph is the patron saint of several countries including Canada, China, Korea, Mexico and Peru. Many cities, towns, and other locations are named after Saint Joseph as well; and it has been noted that the Spanish form of Saint Joseph, San Jose, is the most common place name in the world.

## PARISH BUILDING & MAINTENANCE PROJECT – A/C INSTALLATION IN CHURCH



*Ray Fontanilla* of *A&I Refrigeration & Air Conditioning Services* started working on the installation of the air conditioning units in our Church on Thursday, March 6. They installed the outside condensers on the third day and completed the job. Being an OLM parishioner, Ray offered to do the job and share his profession and expertise for the improvement of our church. On March 12, *Remar Aquino* of *Remar Electric* worked on the electrical lines that will power the

A/C system. Remar and his assistants, *Dominic & Jay-R Escalona* finished the job on the third day. *Roger Isidro* stood by to assist and supervise and provide food and other needs together with

his wife, Aida.

The trial run of the system will be done on Monday, March 17, and we hope and pray that everything will go well.

The rising temperature and humidity prompted the project. We certainly want to feel comfortable when we are in church worshipping and celebrating the sacred liturgy. The A/C units will supplement the existing wall fans when it gets exceptionally hot and humid. So, they are switched on only as needed, and when they're on they help reduce the noise outside because we have to shut off the jalousie windows and doors.

As the project went on, the monetary donation and support of parishioners flowed in. (Please see the list of donors on page 2) With your contribution and with God's grace, we hope that this project may be realized in time for the celebration of our parish 155<sup>th</sup> anniversary. We sincerely thank the generous souls who responded to our appeal and have given from their heart. May the Lord bless you abundantly.
