Pastor's Corner

Fourth Sunday of Lent

First Reading
Joshua 5:9, 10-12

Second Reading 2 Corinthians 5:17-21 Responsorial Psalm

Psalm 34:2-7

Gospel

Luke 15:1-311-32

FOCUS: The Lord is kind and merciful.

Today's psalm is a joyful song of thanksgiving and remembrance. We know the history of Moses' role in God delivering the Israelites from bondage, and we have heard the story of the barren fig tree, but the psalm allows *us* that moment of connection to God in our own particular way. He has pardoned us; he has healed us; he redeems us from destruction; he is merciful and gracious and surpassing in kindness. Our story is not just what happened then, but what is happening now, and the Lord indeed is kind and merciful.

First Reading: Exodus 3:1-8, 13-15

In the first reading, Moses encounters God in a burning bush, and is commissioned by God to free the Israelites from Egypt

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 10:1-6, 10-12

God reveals his name to Moses, saying, *I am who am*. In the second reading, Paul warns the Corinthians against overconfidence by recounting the story of the Israelites

Gospel: *Luke* 13:1-9

In the Gospel, Jesus calls for repentance and tells a parable of a barren fig tree.

STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION CHRISTIAN STEWARDS: "BLESSED, GRATEFUL, GIVING"

Many years ago, I was given a handcrafted wall plaque that reads, "thankful, grateful, blessed." It has been hanging in my kitchen ever since and has accompanied my husband and I through multiple moves, to multiple kitchens. I have seen other wall hangings and greeting cards with the same three words, in the same order: thankful, grateful, blessed.

While I am often drawn to reflect on these three words and their deep spiritual meaning, it has always seemed to me that the words are "mis placed," in reverse order. First, we are blessed. The initiative is always on the part of God. In fact, we are and will always be more richly blessed than we can begin to comprehend. God loves us first. The more deeply we come to know our blessedness, and grasp that our blessed state is an outpouring of the grace of God, the greater must be our growth in gratitude, in thankfulness. The life and growth of the steward is of recognizing the blessings and growing in gratitude for them, which leads to our grateful response. The plaque on the wall should read, I believe, "blessed, grateful, thankful." Or better yet, "blessed, grateful, giving."

On our best days, we are keenly aware of the blessings of life: faith, relationships, talents, gifts, and resources. We are awake to and aware of the world around us and see God's hand in all of creation. Yet in our human frailty, we lose sight. We fail to perceive and become blind to the blessings within and around us. We even go so far as to take it all for granted, and sometimes yearn for more, searching for more earthly wealth and material riches rather than seeking and finding what is always there — the presence of God in our very midst.

In this extended moment of Ordinary Time before Lent, let us be mindful that nothing in this life is "ordinary." All is extraordinarily and abundantly filled with the life and grace of God, which we are called to steward well.








PARISH - A/C INSTALLATION IN CHURCH

The installation of the new split-type air conditioning units together with the outside condensers and electrical lines is now completed. The contractors Ray Fontanilla of A&I Refrigeration & Air Conditioning Services and his crew as well as Remar Aquino of Remar's Electric LLC and his crew employed their professional expertise and finished the whole project after three days each of separate straight work. Roger Isidro stood by to assist and supervise and provide logistics and other needs together with Carlito Centino. Meanwhile Aida Isidro, and the office manager, Fran Kovaloff did some errands to serve meals and snacks. Of course, the project is made possible by the responsive financial support of generous parishioners. Big and small they all combined to pay up the incurred expenditures. After the test run on March 17, our Pastor Fr. Edgar officiated the blessing of the completed A/C system in the Church. He also invoked God's special blessing on the professional contractors and their crewmen, our building and maintenance and parish personnel and all the benevolent donors. Special mention is due to the Portuguese Catholic Club. Irmandade de Nossa Senhora du Monte. for their sizable donation and for being often the first to help. The project's biggest surprise is the unexpected donation of the entire A/C units and their installation labor by parishioner Ray Fontanilla and his company, A&I Refrigeration LLC. The expenses went to the installation of electrical lines which included fixing the old panel board as well as installing a new panel. Expenses also went to the painting materials and labor on the placement site of the outside condensers on the mauka ledge of the church and on the electrical piping.

With your monetary contribution and with God's grace, the project is realized in time for the celebration of our parish 155th anniversary. We sincerely thank the generous souls who responded to our appeal and happily gave from the bounty of their hearts. May the Lord bless you abundantly.


