



Pastor's Corner

Next Sunday's Reading

Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles

First Reading

Acts of the Apostles
12:1-11

Responsorial Psalm

Psalm: 34:2-9

Second Reading

2 Timothy 4:6-8, 17-18

Gospel

Matthew 16:13-19

FOCUS: Jesus makes a gift of himself to us.

On the feast of Corpus Christi, the second reading offers the earliest account of the institution of the Eucharist. Jesus tells his disciples that his body and blood are given for them and commands them to [do this in remembrance of me](#). Jesus provides more than a meal; he gives us his very self, broken for us on the cross. Every time Mass is offered, Jesus' sacrifice on the cross is re-presented and we are once again able to receive this gift of himself.

First Reading: *Genesis 14:18-20*

In the first reading Melchizedek, king of Salem, brought out bread and wine and blessed Abram. Then Abram gave Melchizedek a tenth of everything.

Second Reading: *1 Corinthians 11:23-26*

In the second reading, Paul tells the Corinthians that on the night Jesus was handed over, he took bread, gave thanks, broke it, and said, *This is my body that is for you. Do this in remembrance of me.*

Gospel: *Luke 9:11-17*

In the Gospel, the Twelve tell Jesus to dismiss the crowds so they can obtain food, but Jesus takes five loaves and two fish, blesses them, and feeds the crowd with them.

PASTOR'S SABBATICAL



Our Pastor, *Fr. Edgar*, has been granted a sabbatical by *Bishop Larry Silva*.


A sabbatical is an extended renewal period granted by the Bishop for the purpose of study and personal spiritual development. Its purpose is to promote personal renewal and foster ministerial effectiveness. A sabbatical is time invested to enhance ministry. Its ultimate purpose is to provide the individual priest with renewed motivation for serving the people of God. It is not ordinarily for an academic degree.

A priest of the Diocese is eligible for a sabbatical after ten years of service and every seven years thereafter. *Fr. Edgar* has been serving in the Diocese of Honolulu for 25 years since 1999 and it is only now that he is taking a sabbatical. Since he continues in the active ministry after the priests' retirement age of 70, it is recommended that he goes for sabbatical. Sabbaticals are ordinarily granted for a period of about 4 months or a semester and with the understanding that the priest intends to return to ministry in the Diocese. *Fr. Edgar's* sabbatical is only 2 months and will return to the Diocese after. For the month of June, *Fr. Edgar* will go to the *Blessed Peter Faber Spirituality Center* of the Jesuits in the Philippines. In July, he will be at the *St. Meinrad Institute for Priests and Presbyterates* in Indiana, USA.

The Bishop in consultation with the Personnel Board is responsible for providing priest to administer the parish and celebrate the sacraments while *Fr. Edgar* is away. The Bishop named the newly-ordained priest, ***Fr. Preston-Jay Castro***, and ***Fr. Khanh Hoang***, the Administrative assistant to the Bishop, to cover for the month of June while ***Fr. Nicholas Apetorgbor***, the current Administrator of St. Catherine Church in Kapaa, Kauai will cover the month of July. They will be staying in the Rectory.



All gifts in this category are **tax-deductible** and will be used towards paying expenses of tuition, room, and board (totaling approximately **\$45,000** per theologian/pre-theologian, annually) for those seminarians enrolled in Theology or Pre-Theology programs.

Not including the overhead and operational expenses typically associated with managing an Office of Vocations, the education costs alone (tuition, room and board) per each seminarian total approximately **\$320,000** over the course of his four years of undergraduate studies in philosophy, four years of graduate studies in Theology, and one year of pastoral formation within a parish community. Because of these costs, and despite the generosity of so many of the faithful, the Office of Vocations operates, on average, annually at a deficit of over **\$200,000**.



