On June 29, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of Sts. Peter and Paul to honor the two great apostles Peter and Paul. St. Peter, one of the Twelve and the chief of the Apostles, the Rock upon which Christ built His Church, and St. Paul "called to be an apostle, set apart for the gospel of God" (Romans 1:1) and Apostle to the Gentiles. Together they are honored as founders of the Church of Rome, having been separately martyred there during the reign of Emperor Nero.

Next Sunday's Reading

Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

First Reading

Acts of the Apostles 3:1-10

Responsorial Psalm

Psalm: 19:2-5

Second Reading

Galatians 1:11-20

Gospel

John 21:15-19

FOCUS: *You are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my Church.*

While preaching and spreading the Gospel after the Resurrection, Peter was arrested by King Herod. Meanwhile, *prayer by the Church was fervently being made to God on his behalf.* The early Church offers us an example of intercessory prayer that we should imitate by praying fervently for the successor of Peter, the pope.

First Reading: *Acts of the Apostles 12:1-11*

In the first reading Peter is arrested, but prayer is made on his behalf and he is rescued by the *angel of the Lord.*

Second Reading: *2 Timothy 4:6-8, 17-18*

In the second reading, Paul tells Timothy that he is being *poured out like a libation* and that he has *finished the race.*

Gospel: *Matthew 16:13-19*

In the Gospel, Peter responds to Jesus' question about his identity by saying, *You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.* Jesus declares that he will give Peter the keys to the kingdom of heaven.



MAHALO! - SEMINARIAN EDUCATION FUND***Second Collection - June 28 and 29**

This week's Second Collection will go towards our "Seminary Education Fund". All gifts in this category are **tax-deductible** and will be used towards paying expenses of tuition, room, and board (totaling approximately **\$45,000** per theologian/pre-theologian, annually) for those seminarians enrolled in Theology or Pre-Theology programs.

Not including the overhead and operational expenses typically associated with managing an Office of Vocations, the education costs

alone (tuition, room and board) per each seminarian total approximately **\$320,000** over the course of his four years of undergraduate studies in philosophy, four years of graduate studies in Theology, and one year of pastoral formation within a parish community. Because of these costs, and despite the generosity of so many of the faithful, the Office of Vocations operates, on average, annually at a deficit of over **\$200,000**.

Your gift will directly contribute to the education of our seminarians and is much needed and greatly appreciated. Thank you for your support and generosity.
