

Twenty Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

TODAY'S GOOD NEWS

Focus: God calls us to humble service. Humility helps us to see ourselves clearly and not to grasp what is beyond our strength. Both Sirach and Luke tell us that those who humble themselves will find favor with God. They also point to a connection between humility and service. The Gospel has a message about whom we welcome into the banquet of our own lives.

First Reading: Sirach 3:17-18, 20
Sirach encourages his child to conduct all his affairs with humility. Ancient wisdom insists that the more humble we are, the greater we are.

Second Reading: Hebrews 12:18-19
Far from frightening, our encounter with God will be like a glorious holiday.

Gospel: Luke 14:1, 7-14

Jesus tells a parable about a wedding banquet. He presents his own version of table manners. He says that the humble who takes the lowest place will be exalted.
