WORLD MISSION SUNDAY

World Mission Sunday is held every year on the second-to-last Sunday of October. This year it falls on 19 October with the theme of "Missionaries of Hope among the peoples."

In a video message, Pope Leo XIV calls on every Catholic parish to take part in World Mission Sunday, recalling how the generosity of parishioners concretely enables and sustains the good work of missionaries worldwide, as he saw firsthand while serving in Peru.

The video begins with the Holy Father recalling that on World Mission Sunday every year, the whole Church prays, united, particularly for missionaries and the fruitfulness of their apostolic labors.

"When I served as a missionary priest and Bishop in Peru," Pope Leo illustrated, "I saw first-hand how the faith, the prayer and the generosity shown on World Mission Sunday can transform entire communities."

Addressing all Catholic parishes, the Pope insisted, "I urge every Catholic parish in the world to take part in World Mission Sunday," underscoring, "Your prayers, your support will help spread the Gospel, provide for pastoral and catechetical programs, help to build new churches, and care for the health and educational needs of our brothers and sisters in mission territories."

"This October 19th, as we reflect together on our baptismal call to be 'missionaries of hope among the peoples,'" the Pope encouraged, "let us commit ourselves anew to the sweet and joyful task of bringing Christ Jesus our Hope to the ends of the earth."

The Holy Father concluded by thanking parishes worldwide for everything they do to help missionaries throughout the world and imparting his Apostolic Blessing.

GOOD NEWS FOR TODAY

FOCUS: To you I call; for you will surely heed me, O God; turn your ear to me; hear my words.

Today's Scripture teaches us about persistence in prayer. The unjust judge gives in to the widow's plea out of irritation, but God is not like that. God welcomes our persistence, not because we wear Him down, but because our prayer opens us to receive the generous love and goodness God is always ready to give. †

FIRST READING: EXODUS 17:8-13 †

This scene reminds us that prayer and perseverance bring victory. Moses' raised hands symbolize dependence on God, while Aaron and Hur show the power of community support in times of struggle. Together, faith and unity lead to triumph. †

SECOND READING: 2 TIMOTHY 3: 14-4:2

Paul reminds Timothy to stay rooted in the sacred Scriptures, for they are inspired by God. Through God's word, we gain wisdom in Christ and guidance toward living lives of goodness and holiness. †

GOSPEL: LUKE 18: 1-8 † Jesus reminds us that persistent prayer shows deep faith and trust in God. Like the widow who never gave up, we too must keep praying with hope, knowing that God hears and will bring justice in His time. †





Stewards of a Missionary Church

The month of October is an ideal time to focus our prayerful reflections on the world and to see its people as a gift from God. The global community is a gift to be received with gratitude and held in stewardship. With the celebration of World Mission Sunday, October is a month that offers Catholics world-wide the opportunity to renew their commitment to proclaim the Gospel and to give a greater missionary focus to parish activities. It is time to reflect on the global context of our stewardship, and to express our gratitude to missionaries who bear witness to Christ in the most remote and challenging places of the world, often with their lives.

The month of October can remind us that being witnesses to Jesus Christ is a stewardship responsibility of us all. In a world experiencing increasingly disturbing forms of alienation and indifference, our communion of faith can offer signs of hope and work to make the planet a home for all people. We are "communion" because of the gift of the Eucharist. And this gift that we celebrate in the sacrament is not something we can keep to ourselves. By its very nature it demands to be shared with everyone. That is one reason the missionary impulse of our Church has always been a sign of vitality in its unique witness of unity around the world.


There are a number of ways you can focus on the missionary activity of the Church:

- Increase your awareness of the wider global mission of the Church.
- Discover ways to participate in specific missionary activities taking place in your parish or diocese.

Let us be mindful this month that we are stewards of the Gospel, called to proclaim it to the ends of the earth, bringing hope to a world that hungers for Christ's peace.
