



THE DEDICATION OF THE LATERAN BASILICA

The Lateran Basilica is the cathedral church of Rome. It is honored as the episcopal seat of the Pope as Bishop of Rome. An inscription placed there by Pope Clement XII says this church is the "mother and head of all churches of Rome and the world." It was the residence of the Popes from the 4th to the 14th century and the site of five ecumenical councils. It was dedicated to the Savior and later to John the Baptist and John the Evangelist.

NATIONAL VOCATION AWARENESS WEEK: NOVEMBER 2-8

VOCATION SUNDAY: November 9

National Vocation Awareness Week was instituted by the U.S. Bishops in 1976 and celebrated on the first week of November. This year the week begins with All Saints Day which is a happy coincidence, because a vocation, in its fullest sense, is our path to heaven and sainthood.

As Catholics, we firmly believe that God has a plan for our lives! He calls some to marriage, some to the priesthood, and others to religious life or to life as consecrated single people. Fully living our own vocations and teaching young people how to discern God's call is a serious duty, but also a joyful one.

During this week, we pray that young people in today's culture will hear and respond to God's call. We strive to do our part to encourage them to consider the priesthood and consecrated life!

We encourage the young people in our homes, families and community – the children, grandchildren, nephews or nieces, students and friends – to be open if God calls them to priesthood or religious life. We urge them to pray about how God is calling them to live their vocation more deeply.

Pope Saint John Paul II had a powerful message to the youth on World Youth Day in 2000: *"It is Jesus in fact that you seek when you dream of happiness; he is waiting for you when nothing else you find satisfies you. He is the beauty to which you are so attracted. It is he who provokes you with that thirst for fullness that will not let you settle for compromise. It is he who urges you to shed the masks of a false life. It is he who reads in your hearts your most genuine choices, the choices that others try to stifle.*


It is Jesus who stirs in you the desire to do something great with your lives, the will to follow an ideal, the refusal to allow yourselves to be grounded down by mediocrity, the courage to commit yourselves humbly and patiently to improving yourselves and society."

FOCUS: God's Presence Dwells Among and Within Us As His Holy Temple

The vision of the new Jerusalem descending from heaven reveals God's promise of renewal and eternal communion with His people. The life-giving waters flowing from the temple symbolize God's grace that restores, heals, and nourishes all creation. As God's holy temple built on the foundation of Christ, we are called to live faithfully and reverently, preserving the holiness of His presence within us. Jesus cleansing the temple shows His zeal for pure worship and prefigures His death and resurrection, through which He becomes the new and living temple of God. We, too, must keep our hearts pure and honor God's Spirit dwelling within us. †

FIRST READING: EZEKIEL 47: 10-12, 19, 22 †

The vision of the life-giving water flowing from the temple symbolizes God's grace and healing presence that brings renewal and abundance wherever it reaches. Just as the waters make the sea fresh and cause trees to bear fruit continually, God's Spirit restores life, nourishes the soul, and brings healing to all who dwell in His presence. †

SECOND READING: 1 CORINTHIANS: 3:9-11, 16-17

We are God's holy temple, built upon the unshakable foundation of Jesus Christ. Each of us is called to build our lives with care and faithfulness, honoring the Spirit

of God who dwells within us. Because we are sacred in His sight, we must live in a way that preserves and reflects the holiness of God's presence in us. †

GOSPEL: JOHN 2: 13-22 † Jesus cleanses the temple, driving out those who turned His Father's house into a marketplace. His zeal for true worship reveals His deep reverence for God's dwelling. When He speaks of destroying the temple and raising it in three days, He points to His own death and resurrection — showing that His Body is the new temple where God's presence dwells. This reminds us to keep our hearts pure, for we too are temples of the Holy Spirit, called to honor God in all we do. †





STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

November: A Month to Reflect on Gratitude and Giving

Towards the end of each year, it is easy for us to become distracted with the busyness and planning for the upcoming holidays, starting with Thanksgiving. As Christian stewards, it is an important aspect of our faith to live each day in gratitude and to prayerfully discern and reflect on what we are giving back to God through our parish, diocese and other charitable institutions in the coming year. Now is a good time to reflect on what priority we will give to God in our spending.


Christian stewards acknowledge with gratitude that even their financial resources and material wealth ultimately come from God. Exercising good stewardship over the money one makes, manages, spends and offers back to God is a tangible measure of their gratitude to God and their spiritual health.

Giving generously to their parish, dioceses and institutions of the universal Church is second nature to good stewards. They prayerfully reflect on their ability to give and return the "first fruits" of their financial resources back to God (Leviticus 23:10). The good steward's desire is to put God first among his or her spending priorities. They take seriously the psalmist's question: "What return shall I make to the Lord for all the good He has done for me?" (Psalm 116:12).

The best way to respond to God's loving generosity is by reflecting that generosity day by day. What God does in Jesus' human life is a much magnified version of what happens when we take time to pray, offer our time and talents to our parish family or when family budgets and spending habits are reprioritized to conform more devotedly to the Gospel. The stewardship question is not, "Should I do these things?" but rather, "How much should I do?" Take time during this month of November to reflect prayerfully on God's generosity toward you, on the quality of your own life of gratitude and what you are doing and can do to further God's kingdom by your own giving patterns in the coming year. 


OUR LADY OF THE MOUNT YOUTH AND YOUNG ADULT MINISTRY
