A BLESSED HOLY WEEK & SACRED TRIDUUM TO EVERYONE!

HOLY WEEK is ordered to the commemoration of Christ's Passion beginning with his Messianic entrance into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday. The days of Holy Week have precedence over all other celebrations.

PALM SUNDAY OF THE LORD'S

PASSION: The Church recalls the entrance of Christ the Lord into Jerusalem to accomplish his Paschal Mystery. Accordingly, the memorial of this entrance of the Lord takes place at all Masses, by means of the blessing

of palms or olive branches, followed by the procession or solemn entrance before the Masses. There is also a sacred celebration of the Word of God on the messianic entrance and on the Passion of the Lord. The gospel of the Passion of the Lord is read dramatically by the priest

taking the voice of Christ and the lay readers to voice individual speakers and the community takes the crowd's voice.

CHRISM MASS (March 31/Tuesday @ Co-Cathedral of St. Theresa): The Mass of Chrism is properly concelebrated by the Bishop with his Clergy. It is a sign of the unity and communion of the priests with their bishop. This is also the proper celebration of the blessing by the bishop of the Oil of the Sick and the Oil of Catechumens and the consecration of the Chrism which is used in Baptism, Confirmation, Ordination, and other occasions.

EASTER TRIDUUM: It begins with the evening Mass of the Lord's Supper, has its center in the Easter Vigil, and ends with the conclusion of Vespers on Easter Sunday.

Since Christ accomplished his work of human redemption and of the perfect glorification of God principally through his Paschal Mystery, in which by dying he destroyed our death, and by rising restored our life, the sacred Paschal Triduum of the Passion, Death and Resurrection of the Lord shines forth as the high point of the entire liturgical year.

HOLY THURSDAY OF THE LORD'S SUPPER (April 2 - 6:00 PM): Before the Feast of Passover, Jesus celebrates the Last Supper in which he gives us His Body and Blood as sustenance for eternal life.

The washing of the feet which the Lord Jesus did to his apostles is re-enacted within the Mass. This year the apostles are represented by the Pastoral Council leaders and members > *Ropati Liua * Marichu Pe Benito * Consolacion Caraang * Teresa Siruno * Fe Go * Julieta Walsh * Norma Daligon * Olivia Mita * Mark Correia * Corazon dela Rosa * Ronnie McCamley * Rosemary Mohika*. The Holy Oils blessed at the Chrism Mass will be processed to the altar by *Amelia and Imiloa Sole*.

The Mass is immediately followed by the solemn exposition and procession to the Altar of solemn Adoration in the parish hall until midnight. All the parish councils, committees, ministries, organizations and parishioners take turns in leading the prayers and hymns by the hour. All the faithful are invited and encouraged to join the adoration of the Blessed Sacrament at their convenient hour or throughout until the Benediction and reposition at midnight.

GOOD FRIDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD (April 3 - 6:00 PM): Today, and if possible, on Holy Saturday until the Easter Vigil, fasting is observed everywhere to honor the suffering and death of the Lord Jesus, and to prepare to share more deeply in his resurrection.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS is held at 12:00 noon. The Novena to the Divine Mercy starts today. The Passion narrative is proclaimed and dramatized as on Palm Sunday. The solemn intercessions are chanted together with the showing of the Holy Cross. The Veneration of the Cross is done solemnly with the faithful coming in procession to do their personal adoration and then drop their offering for the Collection to the Holy Land.

HOLY SATURDAY (April 4 - 7:00 AM): It is the day of proximate preparation for the celebration of Easter and the reception of the Sacraments of Initiation for the Elect (Catechumens). This day reflects on the image of Jesus crucified and lying on the tomb as well as the image of the sorrowful Virgin Mary grieving over her beloved Son. We take this time to pray the second day of the Novena to the Divine Mercy and administer the Rite of holy anointing to the Catechumens.

THE EASTER VIGIL IN THE HOLY NIGHT (April 4 - 6:00 PM): It is the solemn culmination of the Paschal Triduum. It celebrates the triumph of Christ over sin and death. Alleluia! If we believe and die with Christ, we shall also rise with him and pass from death to new life.

- This is an exciting moment for our Catholic community — a renewed opportunity to come together, share God's gifts, and support the ministries that help our Church thrive today and into the future.

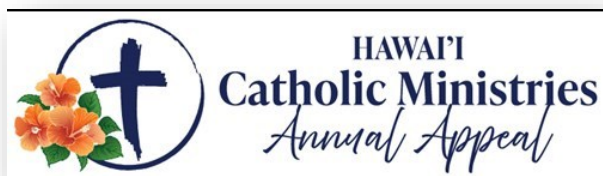

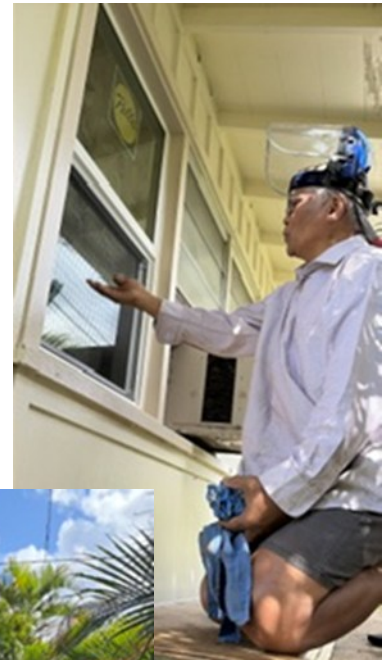
JEAN IIDA > former resident of Kalihi Valley and now lives in Kauai donated \$1K for the Parish fund.
