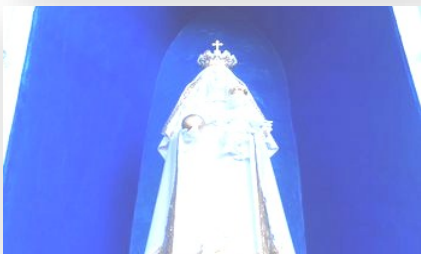

MESSAGE FROM BISHOP LARRY SILVA

Joseph Dutton Day in Hawaii

Dear Fathers and Deacons,

Peace be with you!

Perhaps you have heard the good news that on April 23, 2026, *Governor Josh Green* signed into law a bill declaring April 27 as “**Brother Joseph Dutton Day**” in the State of Hawaii from now on. We are grateful to the Lord for this civic recognition of a man whom the Diocese of Honolulu has officially proposed for beatification and canonization to the Dicastery for the Causes of the Saints as “*Servant of God Joseph Dutton, Layman.*” April 27 is Joseph Dutton date of birth in 1843.

While it is not permitted to promote the same liturgical honors that can be given to a Blessed or a Saint, I encourage you to remember Joseph Dutton in your prayers and Masses that day. Here are possible prayers you might add to the Universal Prayer on April 27:

*That Servant of God Joseph Dutton, Layman, will be honored and imitated in his faith and dedication to serve those who are most in need, and that his intercessory prayers may lead to his beatification and canonization, we pray to the Lord.

OR

That as we celebrate this first “Joseph Dutton Day” in the State of Hawaii, we may be inspired by his selfless example of faith and devotion, and that our prayers for his beatification and canonization may be granted to this Servant of God Joseph Dutton, Layman, we pray to the Lord.

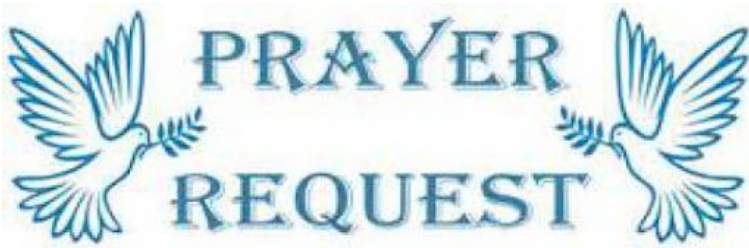

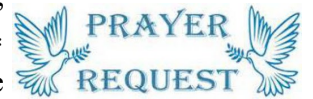
