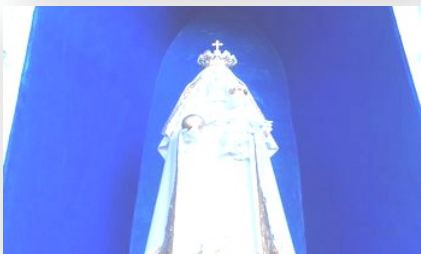

Divine Mercy Sunday

The *Second Sunday of Easter* is celebrated as **Divine Mercy Sunday**. This Sunday is a privileged occasion of grace and forgiveness for all people. A special plenary indulgence is made available under the usual conditions of going to confession, receiving Holy Communion and praying for the intentions of the Holy Father. The prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father is led by the priest towards the end of this Sunday Masses. In preparation for the feast, the 9-day novena and Chaplet of Divine Mercy was recited in every Mass start-

ing on Good Friday and culminating on this Saturday.

God's everlasting mercy finds its purest expression in the sacrifice of God's only Son and will continue to overflow into all of God's creation until the end of time. Aware of God's mercy, we are called to be merciful and forgiving to one another.

LITURGICAL NOTES

On Sundays during the Easter season, instead of the customary Penitential Rite, the blessing and sprinkling of water may take place as a reminder of our baptism.

The water fountain which was set up and blessed on Easter Vigil remains in its location throughout the fifty days of the Easter season.

*The paschal candle which is a symbol of the presence of the Risen Christ among the people of God remains in the sanctuary near the altar through Pentecost Sunday.

*Easter flowers or festive plants and flowers are maintained and kept fresh to decorate the church throughout Easter time.

*According to the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (OCIA), the Fifty Days of Easter make up the **Period of Mystagogy**. *Mystagogy* means “savoring the mysteries.” This is the time for the newly initiated and the entire community to deepen their grasp of the paschal mystery through participation in the Eucharist, meditating on the Scriptures, and involving in works of charity. The newly baptized and their godparents are now regular part of the assembly of God’s people.



ALTAR PANEL OF THE CATHEDRAL BASILICA

The Cathedral Basilica of Our Lady of Peace in downtown Honolulu is the Mother Church in the Diocese of Honolulu. Herein is located the *cathedra* of the Bishop of Honolulu, meaning his seat, from which he presides over our local church.

The Cathedral is very historic. It is one of the oldest buildings in Honolulu, dedicated in 1843 and in continuous use since then. In 1864, St. Damien was ordained priest in this Church. In 1883, St. Marianne Cope and her Franciscan Sisters worshipped there when they first arrived in Hawaii. The Cathedral was raised to the status of Minor Basilica in 2014, bestowing upon it a special Papal honor due to its beauty and rich history.

At this time, the Cathedral Basilica is closed for a complete and much-needed renovation. Upon reopening, it will continue not only as a site for Sunday and weekend worship, but as a place of pilgrimage for all in the diocese and throughout the world who come and venerate

the mortal remains of St. Marianne Cope and the relic of St. Damien, which are enshrined in a special Reliquary Chapel.

Part of the renovation is the putting up of a new marble altar which will have eight arched panels on its sides. Every panel is engraved with a mosaic Hawaiian quilt-type pattern of the flower of each island. Before the altar is assembled, however, each island is being afforded the opportunity to venerate its own panel.

The Oahu panel is already going around the parishes in West Honolulu which include us at OLM. On **April 13, Monday**, St. Philomena Church is passing onto us the panel. At **6:00 PM** we gather to venerate the panel dedicated to the Island of Oahu and marked with the island flower, the *Ilima*. Our prayer is that we all may be one with our brothers and sisters throughout the islands in giving witness to Jesus, whom we encounter in a special way on the altar and in the Eucharist. The panel will stay with us until April 19. Booklets for prayers and devotions will be provided for our use in the presence of the sacred panel. PLEASE COME AND JOIN US.

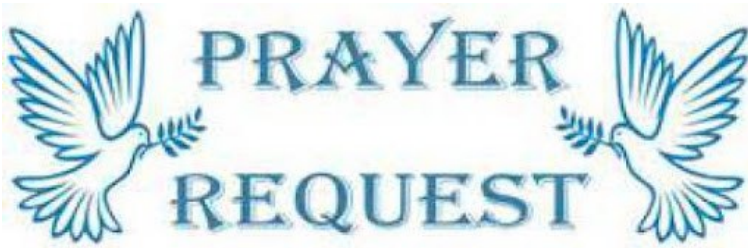

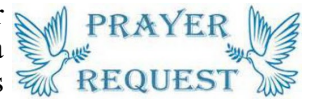
