We pray this in Jesus' name.

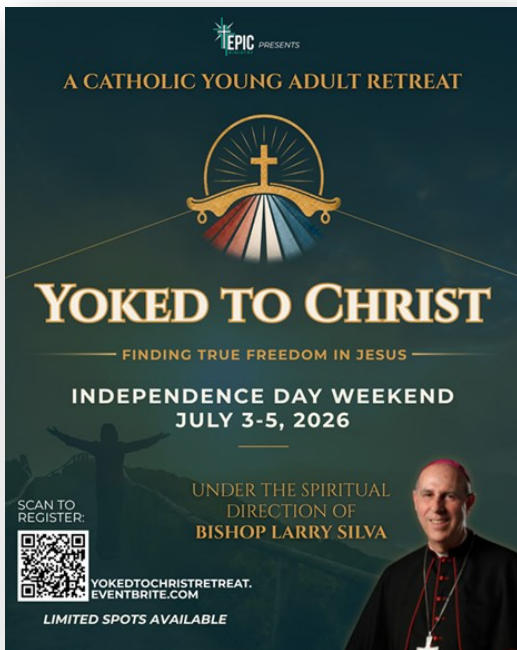

As we approach the final month of the active phase of the 2026 Catholic Ministries Annual Appeal, we would like to thank you for your continued efforts and partnership. Please find attached the CMAA progress report through May 31, 2026.

As discussed during the CMAA webinars prior to the launch of the appeal, while participation in the appeal is not mandatory, each parish is expected to put forth its best effort in support of the campaign. If a parish does not reach its assigned goal and best effort has not been demonstrated, the parish will be responsible for paying the difference between the amount raised and its assigned goal.

At the same time, we want to remind parishes that there is still time to reach and exceed your goal. While the active phase of the appeal concludes on June 30, 2026, any gifts received through December 31, 2026 will continue to count toward your parish's 2026 CMAA goal. Since parishes will no longer be asked to formally promote the appeal during Masses and other parish activities after June 30, we encourage any parish needing additional support to reach out soon so we can help position you for success. We also want to remind parishes that any funds raised above a parish's assigned goal are returned directly to the parish to support its own ministries and pastoral needs.

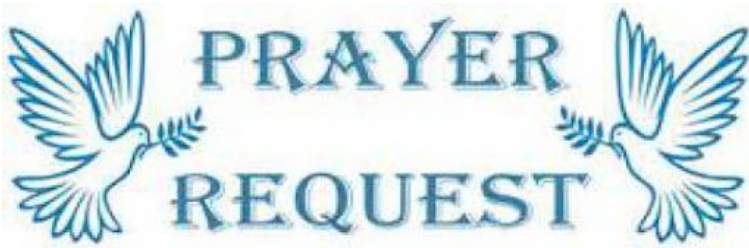

Stewardship Reflection: *Understanding Stewardship in a Complex World*

In Saint John’s Gospel, Jesus alludes to the lives of action his disciples will lead. He speaks to God about his followers: “I do not ask that you take them out of the world, but that you keep them from the evil one” (John 17:15). As a communion of Christian stewards, we live our Catholic faith in a challenging world.

We see overwhelming problems and social ills, and we’re bombarded from so many sides to take action. We are sometimes hit by “compassion fatigue,” and often the issues are complex and our response unsure. However, we know that our Catholic faith is a communal faith, not meant to be lived in isolation. Our prayer and spirituality serve as a springboard to a life of Christian charity and service to others in some form or fashion.

There are a host of Catholic agencies that can help us better understand Catholic social teaching and how we apply that teaching to the complexity of world issues that surround us. Catholic Relief Services and Jesuit Refugee Services, to name just two, deal with international issues with a focus on faith, and Catholic Charities USA focuses on domestic issues. But are you aware that our United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) addresses many issues on the domestic and international front, through its educational resources as well as its activities? Many times, news reports focus on the Church’s position on one or two issues. But in reality, the bishops are very active and outspoken on a wide range of social concerns, and by joining with them as people of faith we can create a united front that promotes positive change and enhances the common good.

Through its teachings and programs, the USCCB addresses issues such as human trafficking, hunger among our nation’s poor, employment, health care, the environment, education and capital punishment.

Visiting www.usccb.org can bring you up to date on a wide range of issues and show you how you can help address them by applying the teachings of our Catholic faith. Together as a communion of faith we can make a difference as we live in this world as Christ directed even in these disquieting times. *(Lifted from ICSC e-Bulletin June 2026)*

Memorandum

RE: PLENARY INDULGENCES FOR SPECIAL JUBILEE YEAR OF ST. FRANCIS
IN THE DIOCESE OF HONOLULU

On the occasion of the Year of Saint Francis, which runs until January 2027, the Apostolic Penitentiary grants a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions (sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer according to the intentions of the Holy Father), also applicable in the form of suffrage for the souls in Purgatory:

- 1) to members: - of the Franciscan Families of the First, Second and Third Orders Regular and Secular;
- of Institutes of Consecrated Life, Societies of Apostolic Life and public or private associations of the faithful, male and female, who observe the Rule of Saint Francis or are inspired by his spirituality or perpetuate his charism in any form;
- 2) to all the faithful without distinction who, with a heart detached from sin, participate in the Year of Saint Francis by visiting, in the form of a pilgrimage, any Franciscan conventual church or place of worship anywhere in the world dedicated to Saint Francis or connected to him for any reason, and there devoutly follow the Jubilee rites or spend at least a reasonable period of time in pious meditation and raise prayers to God so that, following the example of Saint Francis, feelings of Christian charity towards their neighbors and authentic vows of harmony and peace among peoples may spring forth in their hearts, concluding with the Our Father, the Creed and invocations to the Blessed Virgin Mary, Saint Francis of Assisi, Saint Clare and all the Saints of the Franciscan Family.
The elderly, the sick and those who take care of them, and all those who are unable to leave their homes for serious reasons may also obtain a Plenary Indulgence, provided they detach themselves from any sin and intend to fulfil the three usual conditions as soon as possible, if they unite themselves spiritually to the jubilee celebrations of the Year of Saint Francis, offering to the Merciful God their prayers, the pains or sufferings of their lives.

The designated pilgrimage sites by Bishop Larry Silva in the Diocese of Honolulu are:

Co-Cathedral of St. Theresa (Honolulu) * St. Francis Church (Kalaupapa) * Holy Trinity Church (Kuliouou) * St. Rita Church (Nanakuli) * Immaculate Conception Church (Lihue) * Christ the King Church (Kahului) * St. Damien Church (Kaunakakai) * Sacred Hearts (Lanai) * St. Michael the Archangel Church (Kailua-Kona) * and St. Joseph Church (Hilo).



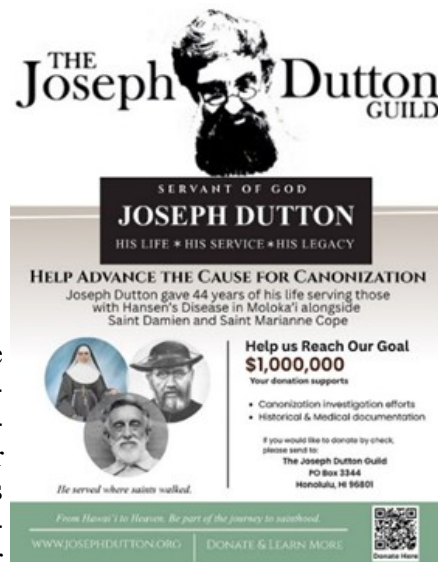

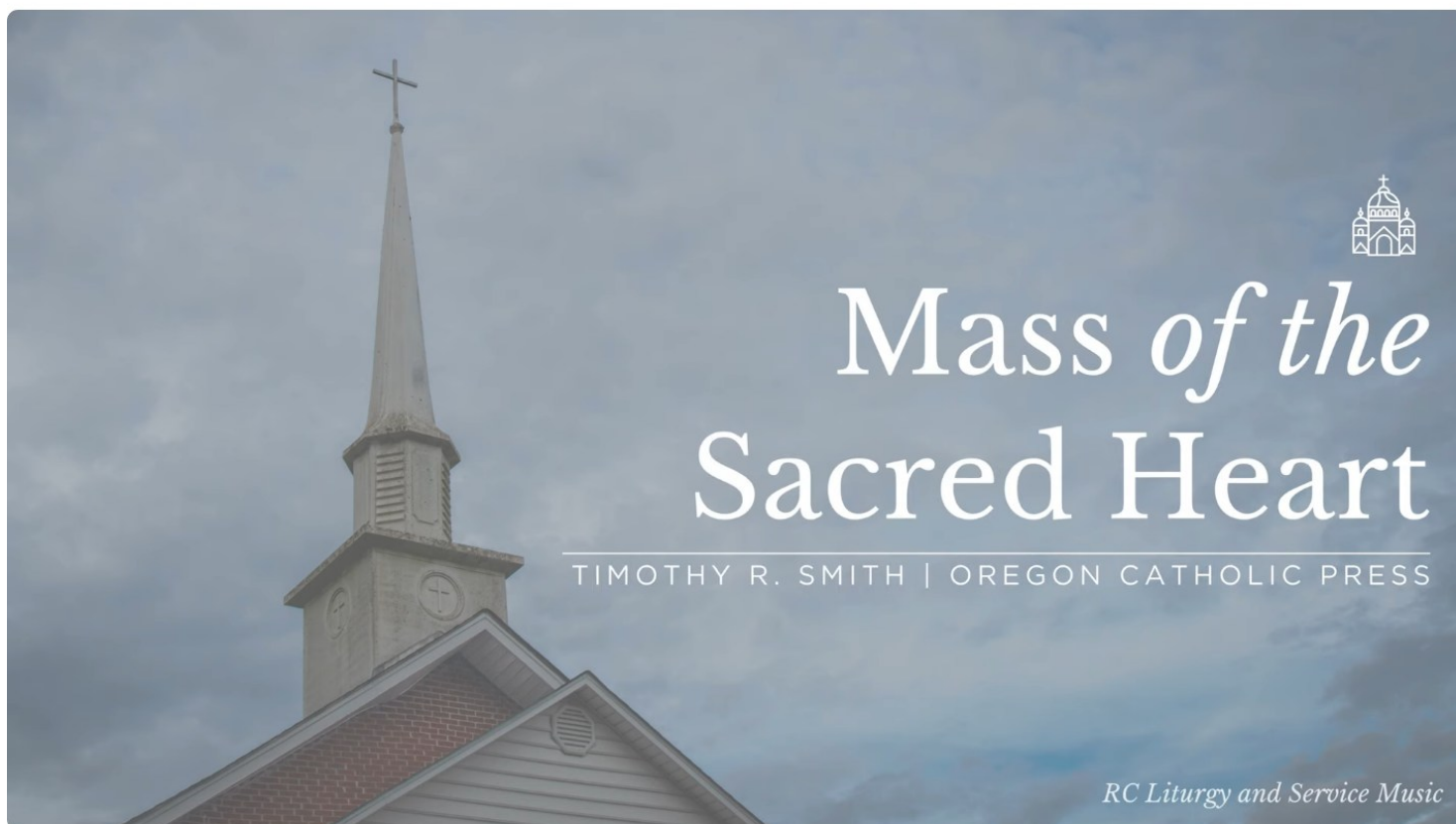
