Happy Father's Day

Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time

The Spirit of truth will testify to me, says the Lord; and you also will testify.

June 21, 2026

Happy Father's Day to all who are fathers or grandfathers or stepfathers! Today, on this Father's Day, we are offering our dads, living or dead, on the altar of God during this weekend Holy Masses and invoking our Heavenly Father's blessings on them.

According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church (#2367), the vital importance of the father's role comes from the fact that, with his wife, he cooperates with God the Creator in bringing a new human life into the world. Children who are raised with fathers present in the family have much lower rates of delinquency, drug and alcohol use, teen pregnancy, and so on, than those with absent fathers. The father's presence is also a significant positive factor in the children's getting a college education, finding a satisfying job, and making a lasting marriage. A girl's choice of partner and satisfaction in marriage is often directly related to the happy and healthy relationship she has had with her father.

Father's Day is likewise a day to remember, acknowledge and appreciate the "*World's Greatest Dad*," OUR HEAVENLY FATHER (Rom. 8:15, Gal. 4:6) Who is our spiritual Daddy, actively involved in all areas of our lives. It is He on Whom we lean in times of pain and hurt; it is He on Whom we call in times of need; it is He Who provides for us in all ways - practical, emotional, and spiritual. When we pray the "Our Father" we experience the love and providence of our Heavenly Father. May all earthly fathers draw strength from our Heavenly Father! On this Father's Day, please don't forget to pray for your spiritual Fathers, the priests who are Pastors, Associate Pastors, active or retired – men who are called to be Fathers of an immensely large parish family through the Sacrament of Holy Orders.

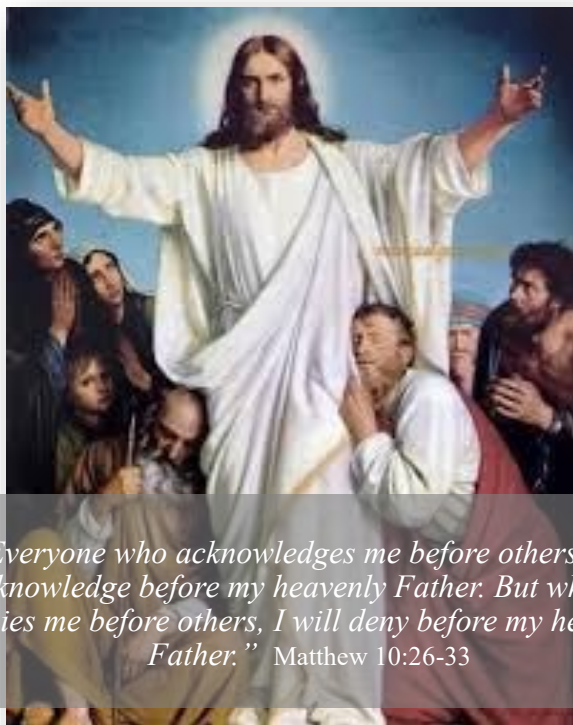

If a parish does not reach its assigned goal and best effort has not been demonstrated, the parish will be responsible for paying the difference between the amount raised and its assigned goal.

At the same time, we want to remind parishes that there is still time to reach and exceed your goal. While the active phase of the appeal concludes on June 30, 2026, any gifts received through December 31, 2026 will continue to count toward your parish's 2026 CMAA goal. Since parishes will no longer be asked to formally promote the appeal during Masses and other parish activities after June 30, we encourage any parish needing additional support to reach out soon so we can help position you for success. We also want to remind parishes that any funds raised above a parish's assigned goal are returned directly to the parish to support its own ministries and pastoral needs.

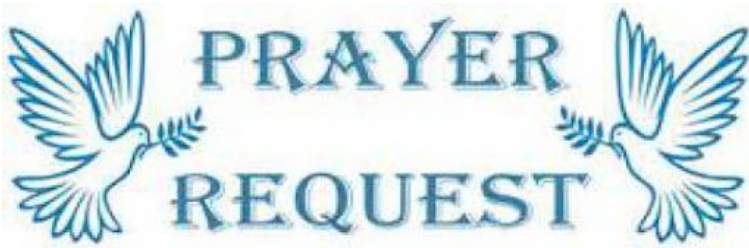

**RE: PLENARY INDULGENCES FOR SPECIAL JUBILEE YEAR OF ST. FRANCIS
IN THE DIOCESE OF HONOLULU**

On the occasion of the Year of Saint Francis, which runs until January 2027, the Apostolic Penitentiary grants a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions (sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer according to the intentions of the Holy Father), also applicable in the form of suffrage for the souls in Purgatory:

- 1) to members: - of the Franciscan Families of the First, Second and Third Orders Regular and Secular;
- of Institutes of Consecrated Life, Societies of Apostolic Life and public or private associations of the faithful, male and female, who observe the Rule of Saint Francis or are inspired by his spirituality or perpetuate his charism in any form;
- 2) to all the faithful without distinction who, with a heart detached from sin, participate in the Year of Saint Francis by visiting, in the form of a pilgrimage, any Franciscan conventual church or place of worship anywhere in the world dedicated to Saint Francis or connected to him for any reason, and there devoutly follow the Jubilee rites or spend at least a reasonable period of time in pious meditation and raise prayers to God so that, following the example of Saint Francis, feelings of Christian charity towards their neighbors and authentic vows of harmony and peace among peoples may spring forth in their hearts, concluding with the Our Father, the Creed and invocations to the Blessed Virgin Mary, Saint Francis of Assisi, Saint Clare and all the Saints of the Franciscan Family.
The elderly, the sick and those who take care of them, and all those who are unable to leave their homes for serious reasons may also obtain a Plenary Indulgence, provided they detach themselves from any sin and intend to fulfil the three usual conditions as soon as possible, if they unite themselves spiritually to the jubilee celebrations of the Year of Saint Francis, offering to the Merciful God their prayers, the pains or sufferings of their lives.



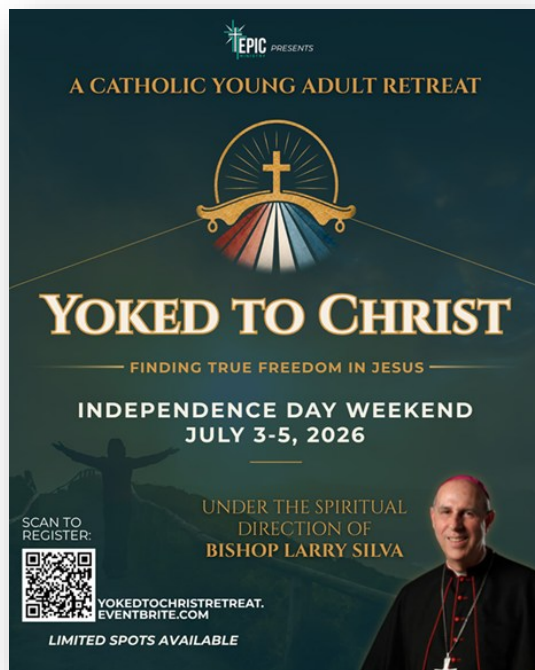

BICENTENNIAL LITURGICAL PLANNING GUIDE

***Introduction**

In preparation for the celebration of the 200th Anniversary of Catholicism in Hawai‘i, the Diocesan Liturgical Commission, under the Office of Worship, is providing this guide to assist clergy and ministers in the liturgical planning for celebrations pertaining to this joyous occasion. All parishes and vicariates are to participate fully so that all the faithful have the opportunity to join together in commemorating this extraordinary time.

***Opening Mass**

The Fathers and Brothers of the Congregation of the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary and of Perpetual Adoration (SS.CC.) arrived in Honolulu’s Harbor on July 7, 1827 and first went ashore on July 8, 1827. They offered the first Holy Sacrifice of the Mass on July 14, 1827.

Bishop Larry Silva has set the date of Thursday, July 9, 2026 to open the bicentennial celebration with Mass being offered on Oahu and in each vicariate of Kaua‘i, Maui, and Hawai‘i Island simultaneously at 6:00 PM.

The Proper of the Mass will be for the ***Feast of Our Lady, Queen of Peace***, Principal Patroness of the Diocese of Honolulu. The presidential prayers can be taken from the Common of BVM or The BVM, Queen of Peace (Collection of Masses of the Blessed Virgin Mary, #45). The Gloria is said, and the Preface of the BVM I-II or the proper Preface from the Collection is used.

The readings are taken from the Lectionary #707-712 or Collection #45 The Blessed Virgin Mary, Queen of Peace: Isaiah 9:1-3, 5-6; Psalm 85:9ab-10; 11-12, 13-14; Luke 1:26-38

The sample ***Universal Prayer*** below may be used and translated into different languages in a multicultural celebration.

***Anniversary Mass**

Parishes are encouraged to celebrate their anniversary of dedication of the parish church in a special way to highlight the bicentennial year. Prayers and music should carry the theme of the Dedication of a Church.

***Community Engagement**

When having Opening Mass and/or Special Masses, we encourage community engagement by inviting Societies, Orders, Organizations, Civic leaders:

- Knights of Malta * Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulchre of Jerusalem
- Order of Saint Lazarus of Jerusalem
- Knights of Columbus

Religious Communities

***Cultural Engagement**

These cultures are part of the Diocese and can be incorporated into liturgies, whether as a lector (in their language) or in universal prayers (in their language), while in cultural attire.

* Hawaiian * Chinese * Chuukese * Filipino * Korean * Samoan * Spanish * Tongan * Vietnamese

The use of the Sacred Gesture in the Liturgy is allowed in the Diocese of Honolulu. As a reminder, the music used must be of a sacred, not secular, character, and is to be appropriate to the liturgical season. Also, since liturgical gestures are acts of praise and worship and not entertainment, applause after the gestures is not appropriate. This should be announced or included in the worship aids as needed.
