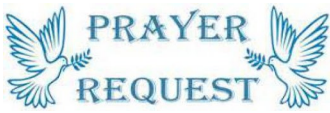

SUMMER FUND DANCE UPDATE

The Summer Fund Dance is an initiative of our Pastoral Council leaders to help produce the seed money for the repair and maintenance of our parish hall. Many of the jalousy windows and screens are damaged or broken and their crank or handles to operate them are rusty, broken and inoperable. During the recent hurricane storm the hall was practically flooded because the windows could not be closed properly. We are looking for bidders to give us a cost estimate of the project.

So, far after one month of diligent efforts by our pastoral leaders, they have sold 194 tickets from the 250 goal. They collected the amount of \$11,460. The target amount is \$17,500. The rest is collectible. We have gone past the median and we are nearing the goal. We appeal to the generous sense and goodwill of every faithful parishioner to render their assistance in disposing the remaining tickets. STAY SAFE – IT'S HURRICANE SEASON!

Last week, it was Hurricane Lala, this weekend is Hurricane Moke. If the Governor declares a state of emergency as on the onset of tropical Storm/Hurricane Lala, so travel may be imprudent. Traveling for Mass could be unsafe or prohibited, placing one's life and the lives of others at risk. Bishop Michael T. T. Castori, SJ, has granted a dispensation for all those affected, so the obligation to attend Mass was not in force. For those who cannot attend Mass, time should be spent reading the Word of God or in prayer to mark the Lord's Day.

God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.
Therefore, we will not fear, though the earth should change,

A Prayer to Avert Storms and Hurricanes

Father, all the elements of nature obey your command.
Calm the storms and hurricanes that threaten us
